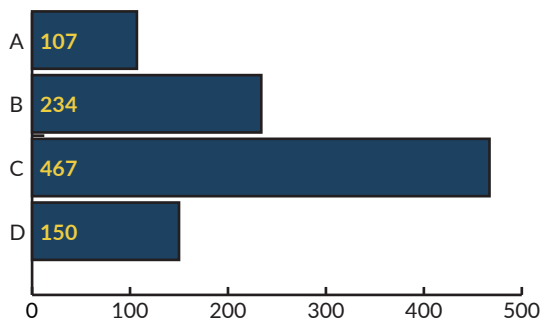

2. If a prosecutor categorically refuses to charge certain crimes, should the state give a special prosecutor the authority to enforce Indiana's laws in that county?



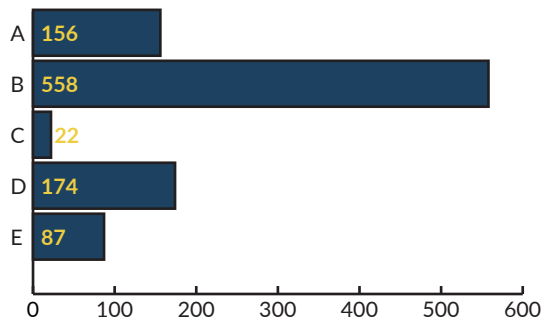

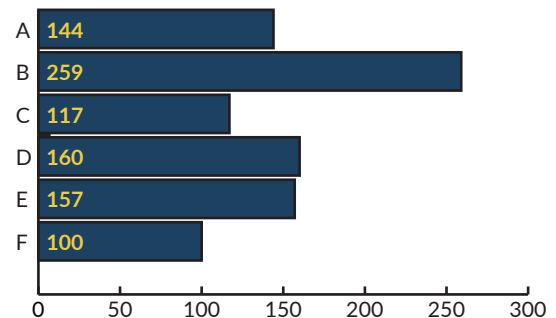

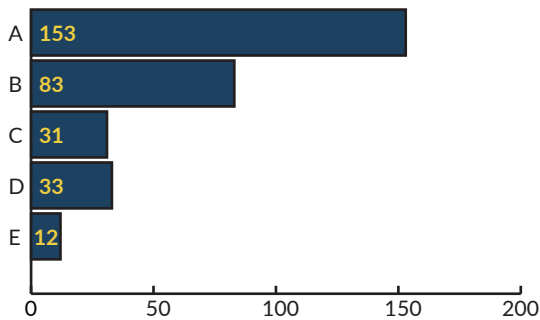

RELIABILITY OF HIGH-SPEED INTERNET

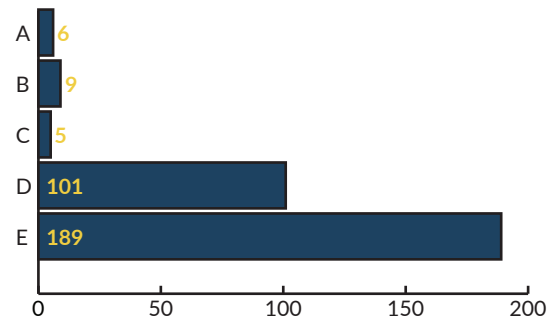

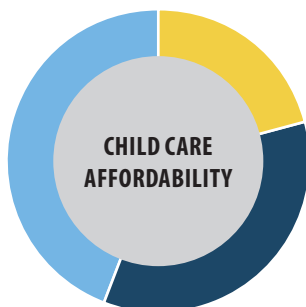
6. How would you rate the availability and affordability of child care in our community?
