- Development Update Alan Boucher Reported the following information;
  - Phase 22 construction is underway
  - Final landscaping around the south pond is being completed
  - The school site is being sodded
  - The hockey rink is being installed over the summer and will be available for the 2018/2019 winter season.
    - The rink will be installed at a cost to Melcor. The City of Airdrie will be responsible for maintaining the rink.
  - 40th avenue construction is underway (city work)
  - Builders still working through phases 19, 16B, and 21
