The Indiana Senate Borst Fellowship is a paid, full-year fiscal policy and research experience available to one exemplary graduate student from the Paul H. O'Neill School of Public and Environmental Affairs.

The Borst Fellowship offers a valuable, hands-on experience, assisting the Majority Fiscal Analysts and Senate Leadership with policy research and fiscal analysis throughout the legislative process.

The Borst Fellow responsibilities include, but are not limited to, tracking legislation with a fiscal impact, staffing fiscal committees, researching various policy topics, and observing all aspects of the legislative session.

BORST FELLOWSHIP BENEFITS

Fall Semester: Earn a \$5,000 semester stipend, working a part-time, flexible 20 hour per week schedule. Enroll full-time in graduate classes and earn academic credit for the V590 independent research study. Tuition reimbursement is available for fall semester SPEA courses (approximate value of \$386 per credit hour).

Spring Semester: Earn a \$750 biweekly stipend, working a regular, full-time schedule with a minimum commitment of 35 hours per week. Enroll part-time in graduate courses and earn academic credit for the V585 Practicum in Public Affairs. Tuition reimbursement is available for spring semester SPEA courses (approximate value of \$386 per credit hour).
