#### **INDIANA OPEN DOOR LAW**

Executive sessions of the Board of Education may be held only in the following instances:
1. Where authorized by federal or state statute.
2. For discussion of strategy with respect to:
<ul> <li>A. Collective bargaining;</li> <li>B. Initiation of litigation or litigation which is either pending or has been threatened specifically in writing;</li> <li>C. The implementation of security systems; or</li> <li>D. The purchase or lease of real estate property by the governing body up to the time a contract or or lease is executed by the parties.</li> </ul>
3. For discussion of the assessment, design, and implementation of school safety and security measures, plans and systems.
4. Interviews with industrial or commercial prospects or agents of commercial prospects by the Department of Commerce, the Indiana Development Finance Authority, the Film Commission, the Indiana Business Modernization and Technology Corporation, or Economic Development Commissions.
5. To receive information about, and interview prospective employees.
6. With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction:
<ul> <li>A. to receive information concerning the individual's alleged misconduct; and</li> <li>B. to discuss, before a determination, the individual's status as an employee, a student, or an independent contractor</li> <li>(i) who is a physician or</li> <li>(ii) a school bus driver</li> </ul>
7. For discussion of records classified as confidential by State or Federal statute.
8. To discuss, before any placement decision, an individual student's abilities, past performance, behavior and needs.
X9. To discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees. This subdivision does not apply to any discussion of the salary, compensation, or benefits of employees during a budget process.
10. When considering the appointment of a public official, to do the following:
A. develop a list of prospective appointeesB. consider applicationsC. make one (1) initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration
11. To train school board members with an outside consultant about the performance of the role of the members as public officials.

\_\_\_12. To prepare or score examinations used in issuing licenses, certificates, permits, or registrations under

IC 15-5-1.1 or IC 25.
