## PAPER HOLIDAY ORNAMENTS

### Easy Paper Fan Cardinal Ornament

Create ornaments at home using supplies you have around your house!

#### ITEMS NEEDED

- Red paper
- Cardinal ornament template
- Scissors
- String
- Black marker or pen



#### STEPS

Step 1: Begin by drawing your own cardinal bird template or print a copy here:

Step 2: Use two sheets of paper for your cardinal. Cut out the two sheets of red paper and glue together to paper more stiff. With a black pen, add the face details to your cardinal.

Step 3: Fold a piece of red paper into a paper fan or concertina

Step 4: Cut a slot in the back of your paper cardinal and insert your paper fan (or paper concertina)

Step 5: Insert your string into the slot and create a hanger for your ornament.

# Paper Tree Ornament

## ITEMS NEEDED

- Green paper
- Yellow paper
- Ribbon
- Colored glitter glue
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Craft glue



## STEPS

Step 1: Draw and cut out a spiral from green paper.

Step 2: Decorate with dots of colored glitter glue and let dry.

Step 3: Cut a star out of yellow paper and attach to the top of your tree.

Step 4: Create a loop for hanging your ornament out of ribbon and attach.

- Scissors

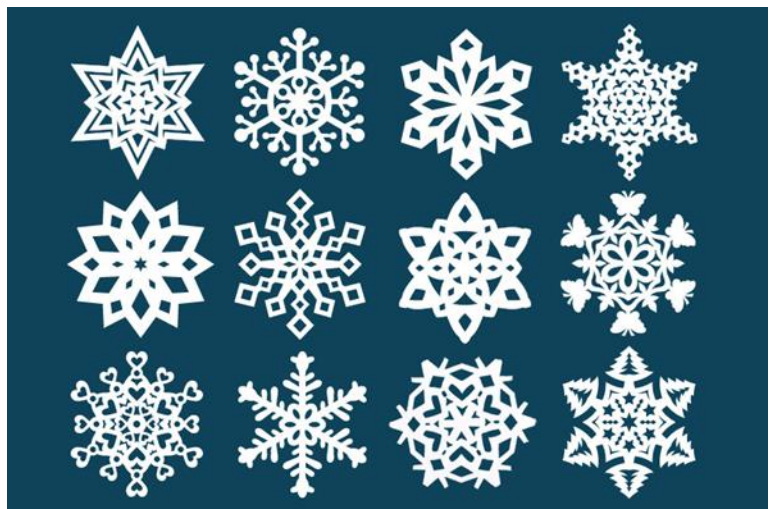
## STEPS
