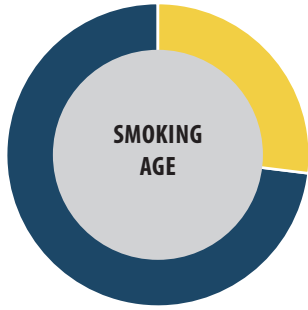




2020 SURVEY RESULTS

STATE SENATOR BLAKE DORIOT

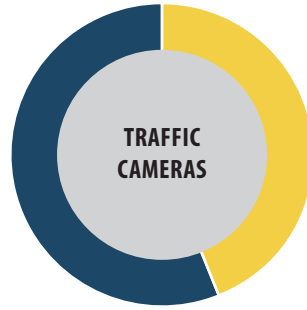

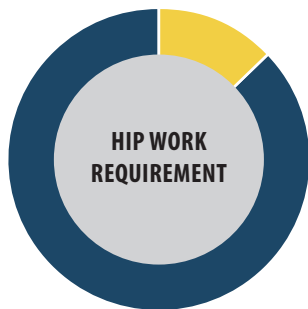
4. Do you support or oppose requiring schools to get parental consent before they provide mental-health counseling to students?

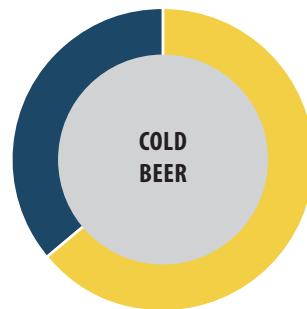
5. Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?
