Ed Harvey: Mentioned that C-9 is looking for a Diesel Program Instructor.

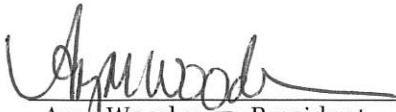

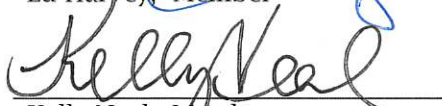
