LJC SIGNATURE PROGRAM COMMUNITY PROJECTS

The Leadership Johnson County (LJC) Signature Program experience creates an opportunity for a cross-section of our community to gather and learn enhanced leadership skills and community awareness. As part of this learning process, the class is divided in to small groups who work together to create a community project to benefit Johnson County. The projects are as unique as the 40 members of the Class of 2020. This tremendous group of leaders persevered through a global pandemic and kept right on learning, growing, and making a difference.



ASSISTing Our Community

ASSISTing Our Community worked with ASSIST, a local nonprofit organization in Franklin that provides counseling and emergency items for victims of domestic violence. The team worked to create a children's therapy room to positively contribute to the healing process of trauma victims and their loved ones. The project group identified and repurposed a functional space to conduct therapy, constructed a sand therapy table, inventoried existing supplies, and purchased needed items to complete the space.

Team Pay it Forward

Team Pay It Forward worked with Johnson County Senior Services (JCSS) to create and launch three promotional videos highlighting who and how JCSS serves within our community. Additionally, the videos provided testimonials, ways to donate and support the organization, and helped to clarify the impact, mission, and vision of JCSS. The group planned a purse bingo fundraiser they were unable to hold due to COVID-19, but USBs were purchased and the promotional videos uploaded for the organization to share in the community.

School Lunch Bunch

School Lunch Bunch worked to build a framework for community-sustained school lunch debt elimination. The group tested a variety of fundraising methods and after affirmation from the Clark-Pleasant Community School Board in February 2020, the team moved forward with six different fundraising approaches. Due to COVID-19, they were unable to complete all of their fundraising ideas, but were successful in raising \$1,375 to help with school lunch debt. The repeatable framework for reducing the school lunch debt-load created by the team is both transferrable to other communities and scalable to many.

PET Project combined their passions of animals and trails and set out to create a Trails & Tails 5K to benefit the Humane Society of Johnson County and Johnson County Trails. The event, scheduled to take place in April, was canceled due to issues securing a venue and the team quickly pivoted to a kitten shower. Due to COVID-19, the in-person event turned virtual, reaching more than 8,600 people with 600 plus engagements, and raising close to \$800 to benefit the organization.

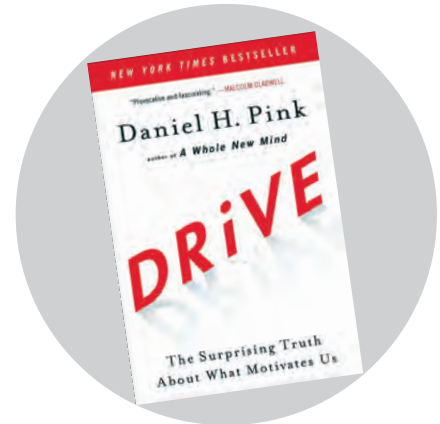
Town Hall Pivot

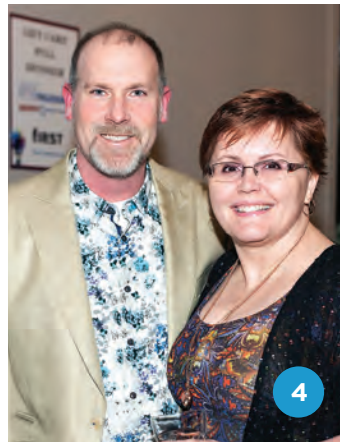
YOUTH LEADERSHIP ACADEMY
