

2019 ICHS SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

Dates: Monday, June 3 through Thursday, June 27

Hours: 8:30am to 11:30am

(Please keep this sheet for your own information.)

IMPORTANT: All courses **except PE** are taught in a virtual, computer-based setting. Initial summer school slots will be given based on early enrollment (first come, first served). If you sign up for two classes, you will complete one before beginning the other. (**Note: if taking PE, other classes are not available to you.**)

All classes will meet on MTWR, no class on Friday.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

1. Enrollment in summer school classes is for incoming ICHS 9th graders (class of 2023) and current ICHS students.
2. All classes, except English(online only) are held at ICHS main campus.
3. You may sign up for a maximum of two online classes.
4. If the class needed is not offered through ICHS's summer school program, please see your counselor for alternate options through Indiana Online Academy.
5. Class of 2023 (freshman) may only take traditional PE courses in summer school. *Classes of 2023 student athletes are strongly encouraged to take PE during the summer.*
6. Students are expected to attend daily. **No more than 1 absence is allowed.** Until credit is earned, students must be in attendance each day. Students will be given home access information on the first day of class which will enable them to work at home in addition to school. Once courses are completed, the student is no longer required to attend summer school.
7. There will be no bus transportation provided for high school students. There is no provision for students to arrive early or to remain on campus after class has ended. Students should not arrive at school any earlier than 10 minutes prior to the start time. Students need to leave school grounds as soon as their class is over.
8. The priority deadline for registration is April 26, 2019.
9. Please **sign the attached form** and **return with payment to the ICHS Main Office.** (Cash, or checks payable to Indian Creek High School are accepted). All 2018-19 book rental fees must be paid before summer school applications will be accepted.
10. After the application is turned in, counselors will check if appropriate class/classes are selected.
11. PE will be taught in the traditional class setting for the full 3 hrs each day.
12. **If taking PE, bring/wear regular P.E. clothes for the 1st day of class.**
13. Students that hope to play NCAA Division I or Division II college athletics should NOT enroll in Grad Point math, government and economics courses through virtual lab or summer school. The NCAA has strict rules regarding which high school courses may count towards athletic eligibility. At this time, Grad Point courses do not meet NCAA eligibility requirements. Potential NCAA students that need online classes should talk to their counselor about enrolling in an NCAA-approved courses through the Indiana Online Academy.

The cost for math, government, and economics is \$50 and PE will cost \$55 (There is no fee reduction for students on free/reduced lunch or textbook assistance). There is no fee for English courses.
