



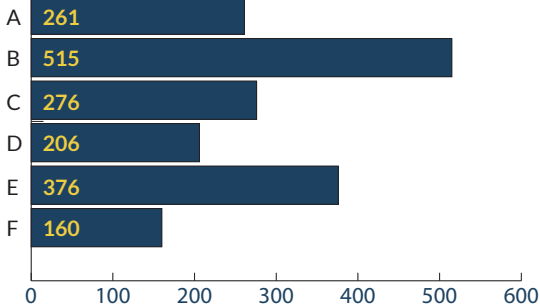

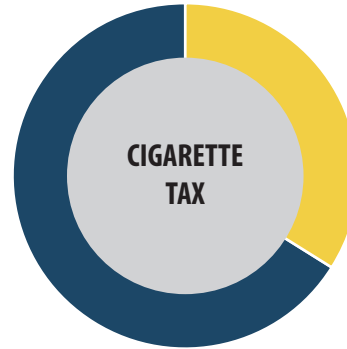
1. When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

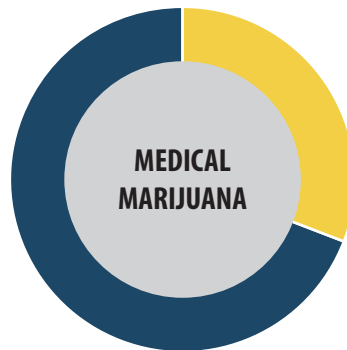

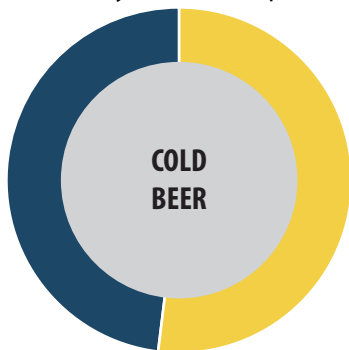
4. Should Indiana legalize marijuana for medical use?

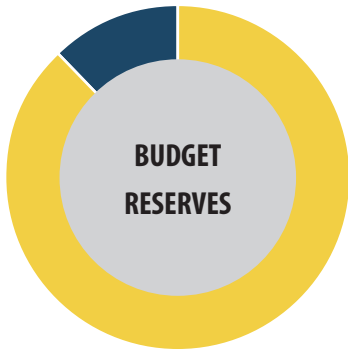

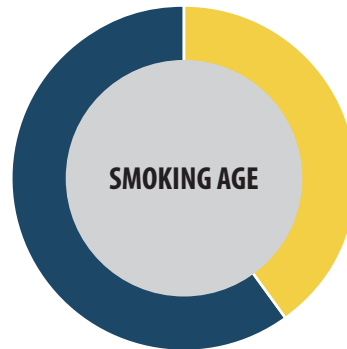

7. The minimum legal age to buy cigarettes in Indiana is currently 18. Do you support or oppose raising the smoking age to 21?



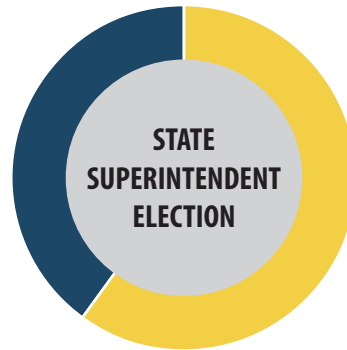

8. Do you support or oppose legalizing sports betting in Indiana?



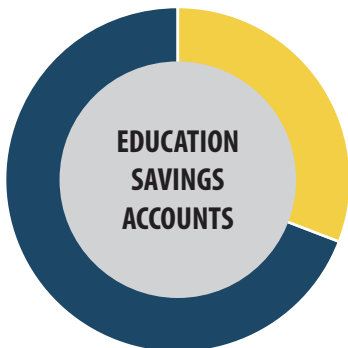

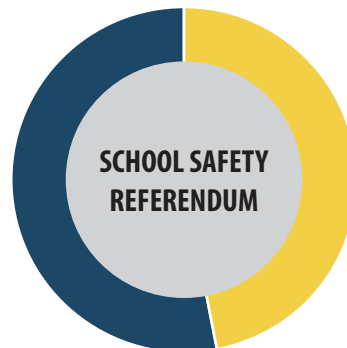

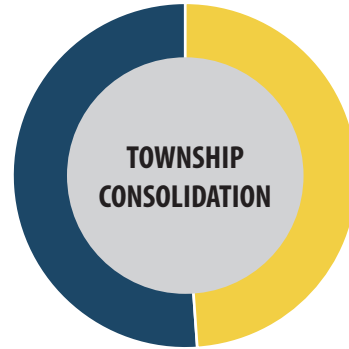
12. Do you support or oppose requiring every Indiana school to conduct active-shooter safety drills?

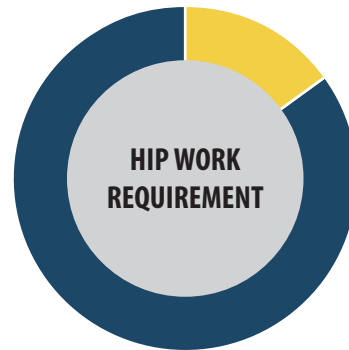
