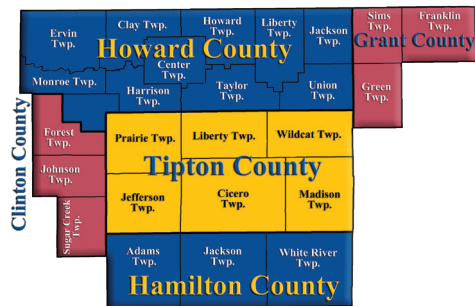
BIOGRAPHY

Since 2008, Indiana State Sen. Jim Buck has served the Hoosiers of Senate District 21, which includes all of Howard and Tipton counties and portions of Clinton, Grant and Hamilton counties. Previously, Buck served in the Indiana House of Representatives from 1994 to 2008.

Buck is Chair of the Senate Committee on Local Government and is the former National Chair of the American Legislative Exchange Council. He also serves on the Senate Committees on Environmental Affairs; Judiciary; and Tax and Fiscal Policy.

Buck holds a bachelors degree and a Master of Business Administration from Indiana Wesleyan University.
