



Direct Access Laboratory Testing at Johnson Memorial Health

In keeping with our mission to provide quality laboratory services that are responsive to the expectations of physicians, employees, patients, and the community through continuous quality improvement, we are pleased to offer a selection of laboratory health profiles and single tests (conducted by the Johnson Memorial Health Laboratory) designed to evaluate your current health status via a simple blood draw – at a discounted price. A physician order is not required.

Below you will find the list of Direct Access Laboratory Testing available. Only the tests listed will be offered via direct access to patients.

Payment is due at the time of registration. Master Card, Visa, Discover are accepted. Medicare, Medicaid, and private insurance cannot be billed.

All tests results will be mailed directly to the patient's home address listed on the Direct Access Test Request form. However, a patient may come back in and directly pick-up their own results. In this situation, they must present with a picture ID and sign a **Request and Authorization for Disclosure of Medical Record Information** form. A copy of the results will then be made and given to the patient upon proper identification. No results will be released via telephone or faxed.

Please note: Direct Access testing should not replace care and treatment from your physician. At no time will a Laboratory employee provide any type of diagnosis related information to a patient. The patient is completely responsible for sharing direct access test results with his/her physician to obtain appropriate diagnosis.

In the event one of the tests selected through Direct Access Testing indicates a critical value (a reading that could immediately impact your health status), you will be contacted via a phone call - at which time the patient is responsible for contacting their physician or medical provider with the results for follow-up care.
