State Sen. Mark Messmer has served southern Indiana Hoosiers for more than 10 years. Messmer served in the Indiana House of Representatives from 2008-2014 and was elected to the Senate in 2014, where he continues to serve today.

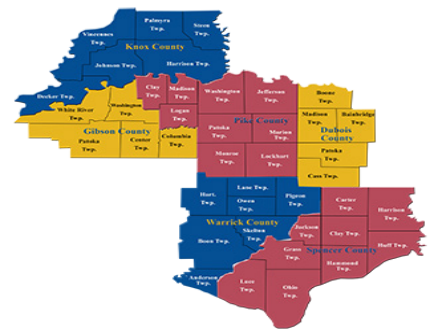
As a state senator, Messmer represents Senate District 48, which includes all of Pike and Spencer counties and portions of Dubois, Gibson, Knox and Warrick counties.

Messmer serves as Majority Floor Leader and chairs the Senate Committees on Environmental Affairs and Joint Rules. He also serves as ranking member of the Senate Committee on Rules and Legislative Procedure and as a member of the Senate Committee on Public Policy and the Senate Committee on Tax and Fiscal Policy.

Professionally, Messmer is the co-owner of Messmer Mechanical, Inc., and holds a bachelor's degree from Purdue University in mechanical engineering.

Messmer's civic involvement isn't limited to his service in the General Assembly. He served as the Dubois County Republican Chair for four years, is currently the Government Affairs Chair for the Evansville ASHRAE chapter, is a member and previous officer of the Jasper Kiwanis Club and a Fourth Degree member of the Knights of Columbus. He is also a member of the Evansville Chapter of the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers and previously served as chair of the society's Government Affairs Committee.

Messmer resides in Jasper with his wife, Kim. They have four children and five grandchildren.
