### BIOGRAPHY

State Sen. Justin Busch has represented northeastern Indiana in the Senate since 2018. He serves Senate District 16, which includes portions of Allen and Whitley counties.

Busch serves as a member of the Senate Committees on Agriculture; Health and Provider Services; Natural Resources; and Tax and Fiscal Policy. He also serves as Assistant Floor Leader for Parliamentary Procedure.

Prior to serving in the Senate, Bush worked for the George W. Bush administration and was appointed to the Indiana State Real Estate Commission by former Gov. Mike Pence. Additionally, he served as an at-large member of the Allen County Council.

Busch attended Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne, where he received a bachelor's degree in interpersonal and organizational communication from Purdue University and a bachelor's degree in history from Indiana University.

He currently serves as a Brightpoint board member and is a lifetime member of the NRA.

Busch resides in Fort Wayne.
