REMINDER - DON'T FORGET YOUR PARENT SURVEYS

The United States Department of Education requires states to submit data on the percentage of parents who believe that their child's school facilitates involvement in the IEP process. In Indiana, this data is collected via a parent survey. Parents should be given an opportunity to complete this survey once per academic year. At the end of their child's ACR meeting, please provide the parent with a copy of the letter from IDOE (below) informing them of the survey opportunity and how the data will be used. You may want to provide the parent with computer access to complete the survey before leaving the school. A hard copy of the survey (below) may also be provided for the parent to fill out and send back in to you in a sealed envelope. Please put these sealed envelopes in innerschool mail to the East Central office and we will mail them to the DOE for you!
