Open Letter to Our Community

We are proud to reflect on a remarkable year for the Foundation. In 2025, we experienced meaningful growth in assets, now exceeding \$67 million, a clear expression of trust in our stewardship and confidence in our role in the Johnson County community. Guided by our 2025 theme, Community at Heart, we remained focused on strengthening connections, supporting local needs, and investing in the people and organizations that make Johnson County thrive. This momentum strengthens our ability to invest responsibly, respond to evolving needs, and support work that benefits our county today while planning thoughtfully for the future.

Last year, our donors, including 892 unique donors, contributed more than \$12.5 million in gifts, fueling impact across our county. Through these generous contributions, we awarded 513 grants totaling over \$3.4 million and provided 201 scholarships totaling more than \$910,000. Together, our total grants and scholarships surpassed \$4.2 million. We also partnered with 22 community organizations, investing \$76,500 in collaborative efforts that address local priorities and create lasting change.

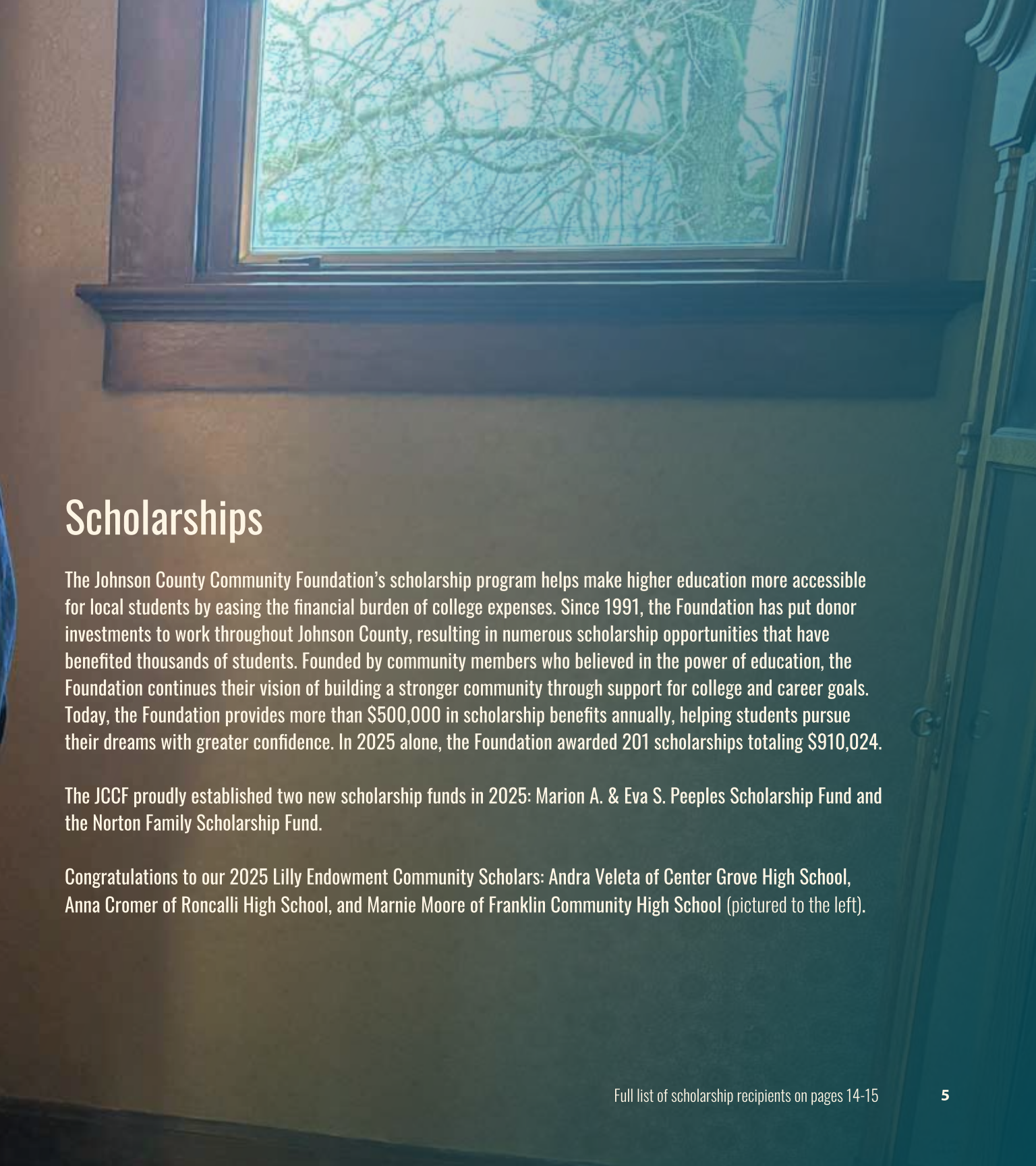


These numbers tell a powerful story, but more importantly, they represent lives touched, opportunities created, and a stronger Johnson County.

Scholarships

The Johnson County Community Foundation's scholarship program helps make higher education more accessible for local students by easing the financial burden of college expenses. Since 1991, the Foundation has put donor investments to work throughout Johnson County, resulting in numerous scholarship opportunities that have benefited thousands of students. Founded by community members who believed in the power of education, the Foundation continues their vision of building a stronger community through support for college and career goals. Today, the Foundation provides more than \$500,000 in scholarship benefits annually, helping students pursue their dreams with greater confidence. In 2025 alone, the Foundation awarded 201 scholarships totaling \$910,024.

The JCCF proudly established two new scholarship funds in 2025: Marion A. & Eva S. Peeples Scholarship Fund and the Norton Family Scholarship Fund.

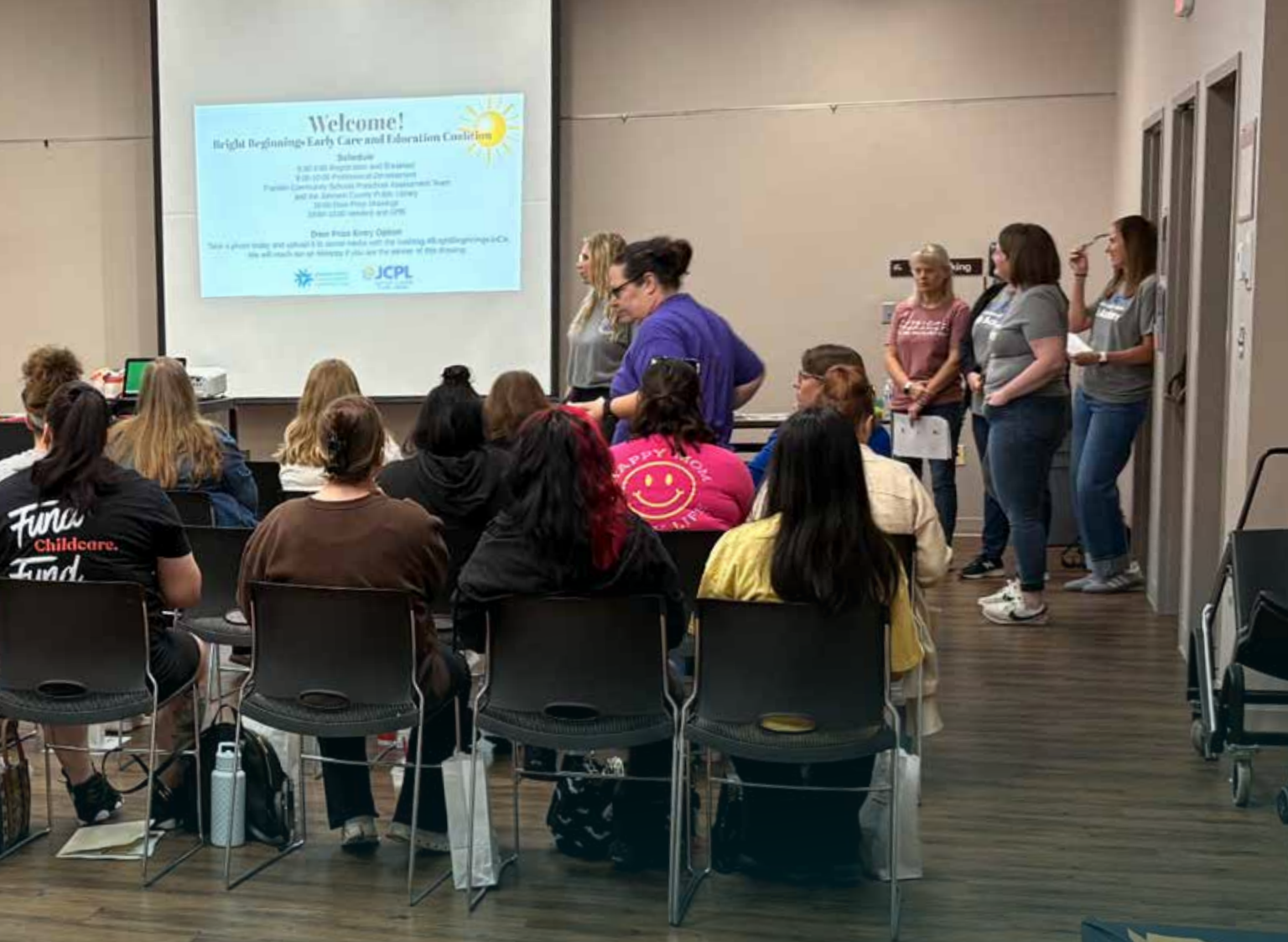
Grants Program

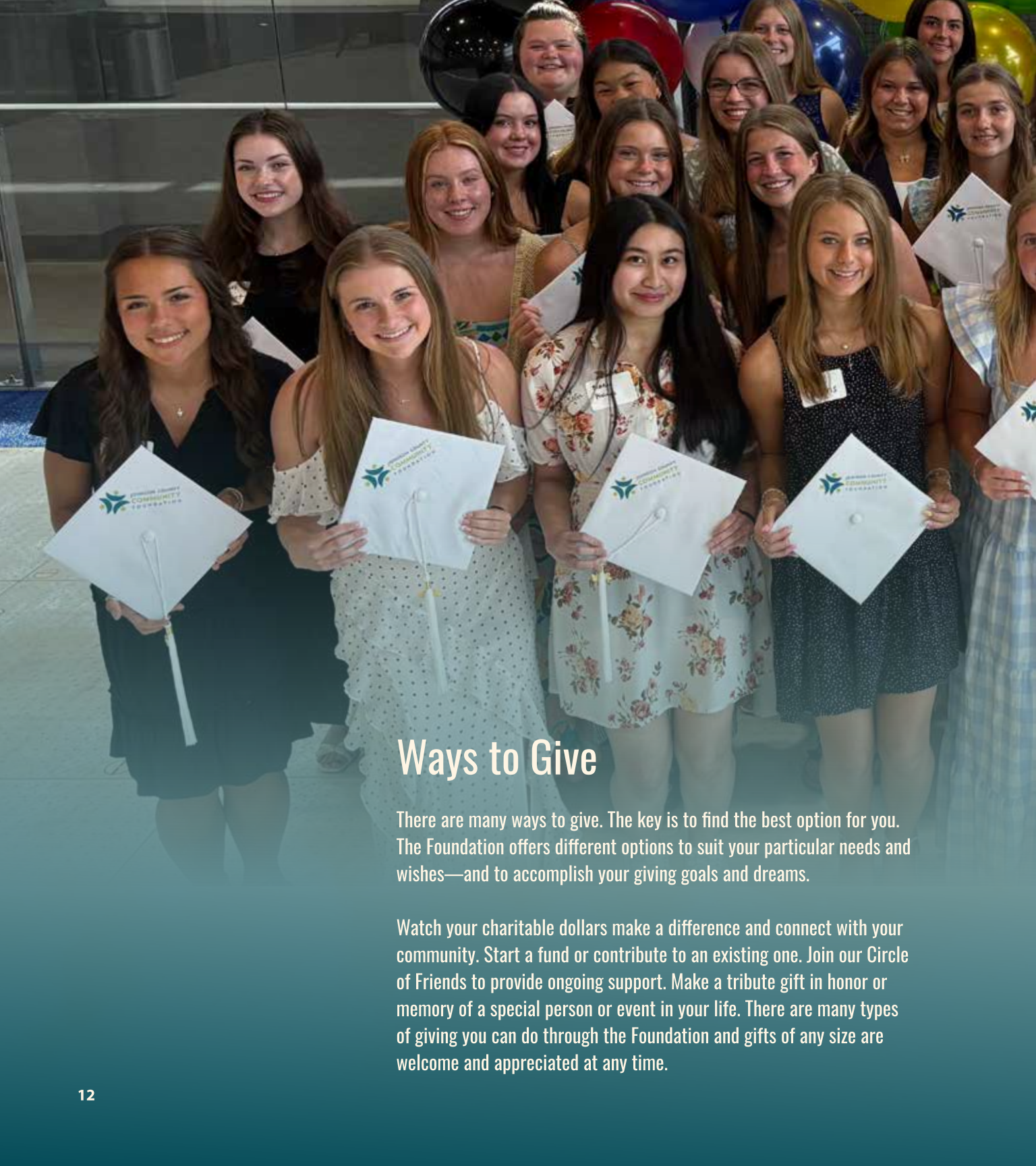
