12. Disposal Inventory: School Buses #99 and #25

Superintendent Borowiak made the recommendation to dispose of school buses #99 and #25 which are rarely used and are costly to maintain. The buses will be sent to auction.

- Superintendent Borowiak shared that the Community Bicentennial Committee has requested to use the football stadium and parking areas for performers to set-up during the celebration. He will bring more information to the board as it becomes available.
- In a COVID-19 update, Superintendent Borowiak stated that all in-person extracurricular activities have been suspended for two weeks beginning November 9th with the first day back being November 23rd.

- Mary Eversole offered her congratulations to newly elected board members, Matt Snyder and Doug Gardner. Mr. Borowiak also offered his congratulations to Mrs. Eversole on her reelection to the board and also congratulated Mr. Snyder, Mr. Gardner.

- Mike Sims spoke to his experience participating in the contract negotiation process.

RESOLUTION
