- 5 WHEREAS, there is already some confusion about which providers are caring for our Indiana patients 6 with physician assistants and nurse practitioners being designated as Physician Providers in some
- 7 advertising by large medical organization and in their physician directories(1)(2), and

- 9 profession to Physician Associates only confusing the patients more about who is providing their care(3), and

- WHEREAS, there are several states in the United States that are licensing graduated medical doctors as Assistant Physicians or Associate Physicians creating more confusion for patients (5)(6)(7), and
- WHEREAS, 76% of Hoosiers believe that physicians should have primary responsibility for
 coordinating patient care(8); now therefore be it
- RESOLVED, that the Indiana Academy of Family Physicians oppose any effort of the Physician
 Assistants in Indiana to change their name officially to Physician Associates, and be it further
- RESOLVED, that the Indiana Academy of Family Physicians continue to oppose any effort of the
 Physician Assistants to have independent practice in Indiana.
