We are expanding! The Franklin Chamber of Commerce recently created an extension of our organization

to serve the greater Franklin business community. The Franklin Chamber Foundation, Inc. is a newly formed, registered, 501c3 organization which will enable us to serve the greater Franklin business community at the next level. The 501c3 designation allows to us accept tax deductible donations and apply for grants which were out of our grasp as a chamber of commerce. No worries, your Chamber isn't going anywhere. The Foundation is merely an arm of the Franklin Chamber.

We recently launched our inaugural project made possible by funds from the Franklin Economic **Development Commission** and the response has been extremely positive! With those funds, we created a pilot program which will award grants for small businesses to focus on capacity-building initiatives to strengthen their businesses.

The application process is now closed and we will take on the difficult task of reviewing and awarding these grants. Grants will be reviewed by members of the Franklin Chamber Foundation Board of Directors as well as representatives from the Franklin Chamber of Commerce, Discover Downtown Franklin and the Franklin Economic Development Commission. These applications will be carefully evaluated on sustainability, business longevity, community involvement and the overall potential impact to the business.

I am delighted to assist in strengthening these businesses that are so important to the vibrancy of our community and grateful for the funding of this pilot program from the Franklin Economic Development Commission.
