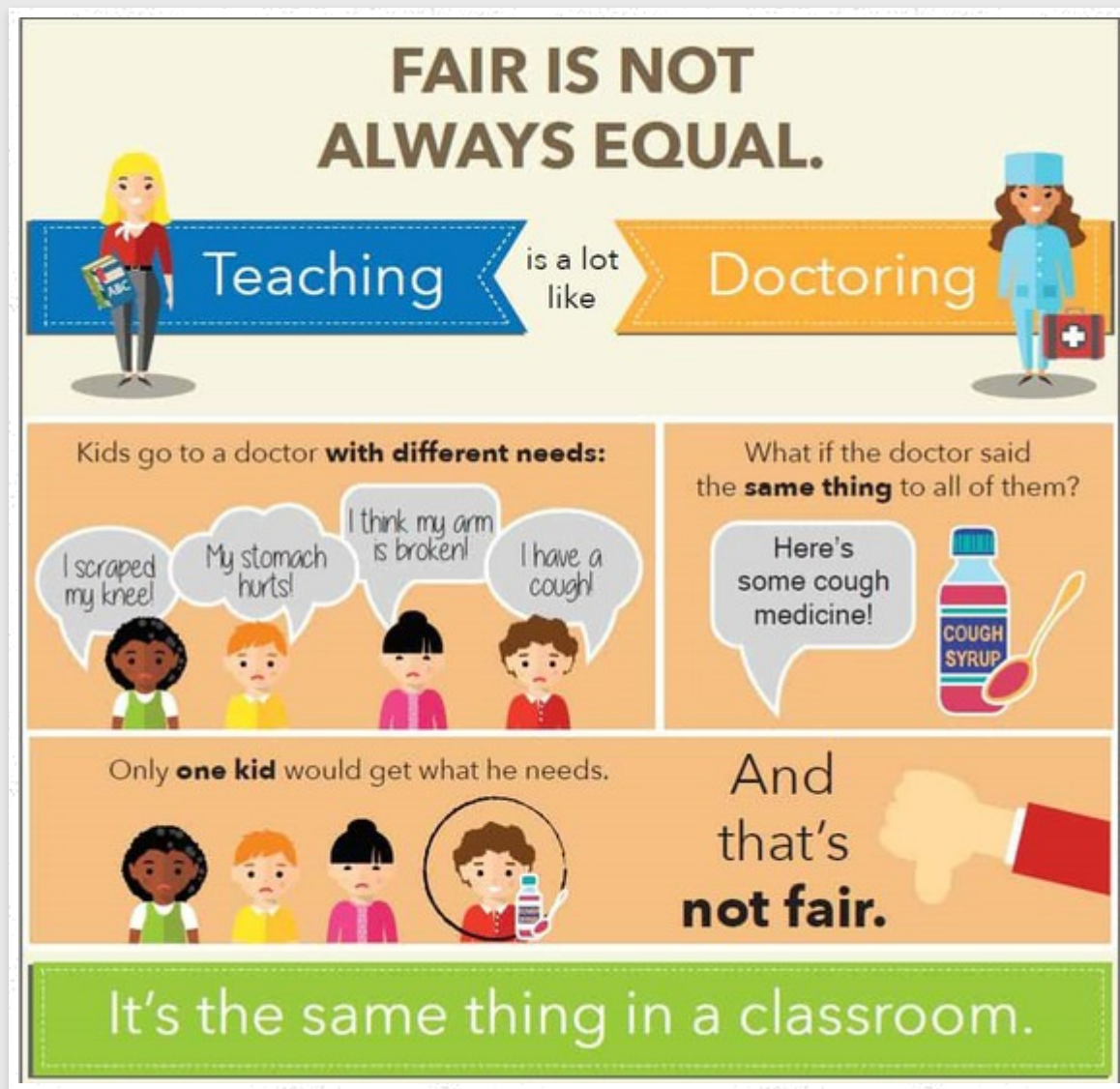

SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICE LOGGING SYSTEM NOW IN INDIANA IEP

Some of you have a spreadsheet or other system already in place to document/log the special education services that you provide to students on your caseload. If you do not, however, here is a potential tool for you! A new Service Logging Wizard is now available in Indiana IEP. Videos demonstrating this logging system can be found [here](#). All services that are listed on the Provisions page in Indiana IEP as "Special Education Services" can be logged using this tool. The type of service provided can also be identified in the log to distinguish between services for math, reading, basic skills, etc.. You can even generate a report under the "Reports" tab for student records. Give it a try and let me know what you think!
