State Sen. Jon Ford has represented Hoosiers in western Indiana at the Statehouse since he was elected in 2014. As a state senator, Ford represents Senate District 38, which includes all of Vigo County and the northern part of Clay County.

Ford serves as chair of the Senate Committee on Elections and as ranking member of the Senate Committee on Family and Children Services. He is also a member of the Senate Committees on Appropriations and Public Policy.

Ford has also served as chairman of the Indiana Arts Commission.

Professionally, he works in business development at a nationwide independent food service management company. He served as co-owner and president of All State Manufacturing for 17 years and is a former board member of the Indiana Manufacturers Association. He holds a bachelor's degree from Misericordia University in business administration and marketing.

Ford's civic involvement goes beyond his service in the General Assembly. He is a former member of several organizations, including the Wabash Valley Community Foundation, Vigo County Youth Soccer, Leadership Wabash Valley, March of Dimes of Wabash Valley and the Swope Art Museum.

Ford and his wife, Kirsten, reside in Terre Haute with their two sons.
