





- Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?
- **2.** Do you support or oppose allowing licensed retail stores, including gas stations, to sell cold beer for carryout? (This is currently limited to liquor stores.)






Should local governments be able to restrict homeowners from renting out their property with short-term rental services like Airbnb?








- Hoosiers currently must register about a month before Election Day in order to vote. Should the law be changed so you can both register and vote on Election Day?




There is currently no restriction on where alcohol can be displayed in a grocery store. Do you support or oppose requiring stores to keep alcohol in a separate, confined area away from other products?




Do you support or oppose requiring all customers, regardless of age, to show a valid photo ID in order to buy alcohol?



Do you think criminals should receive longer sentences if they committed their crime because of prejudice against a specific trait of the victim such as race, religion or gender?




10. Should a person be required to pay a fee and undergo a background check in order to get a permit to carry a handgun in public?

12. In order to limit prescription drug abuse, should doctors be required to check a patient's prescription history before issuing a new prescription?






Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health-care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?






Indiana schools currently set their own calendars.
