# AN OPEN LETTER TO OUR *Community*



Thanks to the unwavering support of our donors and partners, 2024 was a year of significant growth and meaningful impact. We are proud to report that JCCF ended the year with **total assets of \$50 million**—an important milestone that reflects our continued financial strength and capacity to support the causes that matter most to Johnson County.

Throughout the year, we received **808 gifts** from **574 unique donors**, totaling an outstanding **\$4.66 million in contributions**. These gifts allowed us to award **406 grants** and **178 scholarships**, amounting to over **\$3.1 million in direct support** for local programs, projects, and students.

Our Circle of Friends program continues to thrive, with **169 gifts totaling over \$60,000**, and we proudly received support from **20 community organizations** through **partnerships totaling \$67,500**. In all, we now manage **387 active funds**—welcoming 17 new ones in 2024 alone.

Looking ahead to 2025, our theme **“Community at Heart”** captures what unites us: a shared love for the people and places of Johnson County. It is that spirit—deeply rooted in generosity and care—that fuels our work and shapes a brighter future for us all.

## ART IN THE COMMUNITY

Greenwood's Tom's Barbershop now displays a vibrant new mural, thanks to the artistic vision of local resident Mandy Freshour. Her design was selected for the 2024 Color the County Mural, a project led by the Johnson County Community Foundation that aims to enhance public spaces through community art.

Freshour, a freelance graphic designer and homeschool mom, has lived in Johnson County for over 20 years. Her concept, inspired by warm summer evenings and Indiana's state insect—the firefly—features glowing lightning bugs drifting among whimsical, windblown dandelions. The serene and nostalgic imagery beautifully captures the magic of summertime in Indiana.

The mural is part of JCCF's Color the County Mural Program, which seeks to bring art into public spaces while strengthening community connections. During the Community Painting Day each year, local artists and residents come together to transform blank walls into striking works of art that reflect the character and identity of their neighborhoods. No experience is required, and all paint and materials are provided, encouraging people of all ages and backgrounds to be part of the creative process.

With Mandy Freshour's imaginative design now brightening Greenwood, the mural stands as a testament to the power of art to bring people together and enrich the places they call home.
