


- 2. Click "Find Plans Now" under Find health & drug plans
- 3. Choose coverage for 2026 and enter your zip code and choose county if required.



- 4. Click "Continue"
- 5. Select Medicare drug plan (Part D)






14. If you take more medications choose "Add Another Drug". When done click "Done Adding Drugs".

17. It will now show the drug plans available in 2026. They will be in order of lowest drug plus premium cost for the entire year if viewed in October through December. They are in order of retail pharmacy that has the best pricing or mail order if you only chose mail order. The top plan will be your best overall price for the entire year. Any total cost on this page includes deductible that you may or may not have to pay depending on the plan and tiers of medication cost.



Notations

- These instructions are intended to help you in finding a Medicare Part D Drug Plan.
- Medications should be entered as prescribed by your doctor. Inaccurate input of medication details can display incorrect Drug Plan results.
- If you need to change your Drug Plan, you can complete your enrollment into the desired Drug Plan through the Medicare.gov website. Henriott HGI Solutions will no longer be assisting with Drug Plan changes during AEP.
- Medicare representatives can assist with determining your best Drug Plan fit and can also help you enroll in your desired Drug Plan. Contact Medicare at 800-633-4227. Please be aware that you could be connected to a representative that may try to enroll you in an Advantage Plan listen carefully.
- You may only be in one Part D Drug Plan at a time. If you enroll in a new Part D Plan during AEP, the old Part D Plan will end on 12/31, and the new Plan will start on 1/1.
- The last application you complete during AEP will be your Plan for the next calendar year. For example, if you enroll in a new plan on October 20th, and in November, you find out you will take a different medication and complete a new application on November 20th, the second application will be your Plan for the next calendar year. The second application cancels the first application.
- All AEP applications will have a Plan start date of January 1st of the following year.
