DELTA TAU DELTA CODE OF ETHICS FOR ARCH CHAPTER MEMBERS Adopted January 21, 2005 – Revised April 4, 2024

All Members of the Arch Chapter of Delta Tau Delta Fraternity shall adhere to and advocate the following principles and responsibilities:

To the best of my knowledge and ability, I pledge:

- I. To act with honesty and integrity, avoiding actual or apparent conflicts of interest with the Fraternity, in all personal and professional relationships.
- II. To communicate information about the Fraternity and its affairs to its constituents in a manner that is accurate, complete, objective, relevant, timely, and understandable.
- III. To comply with the rules and regulations of (a) federal, state, provincial, and local governments; (b) other private and public regulatory agencies; and (c) the Fraternity's host institutions, as they pertain to my activities on behalf of the Fraternity.
- IV. To operate in good faith diligently and competently, without misrepresenting material facts or allowing my independent judgment to be subordinated.
- V. To refrain from taking advantage of any member of the Fraternity through manipulation, concealment, misrepresentation, or any other practice of unfair dealing.
- VI. To maintain the confidentiality of information obtained during my work for the Fraternity, except when authorized or legally obligated to disclose, and to not use such information for personal advantage or gain.
- VII. To be an accountable and responsible partner among peers in all levels of the Fraternity's affairs by proactively promoting ethical behavior.
- VIII. To ensure responsible use of, and stewardship over, all assets and resources of the Fraternity employed or entrusted to me, and to ensure that the Fraternity's assets are solely used for legitimate business purposes.
- IX. To model mature, thoughtful, and responsible behavior in the presence of undergraduate members and alumni of the Fraternity.
- X. To be accountable to the Fraternity for adhering to this Code of Ethics, I vow to support and uphold these principles.
