



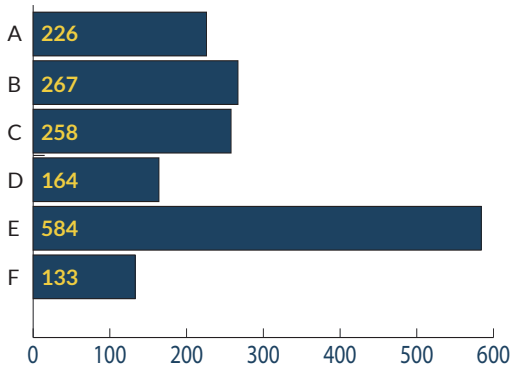

## STATE SENATOR RON ALTING

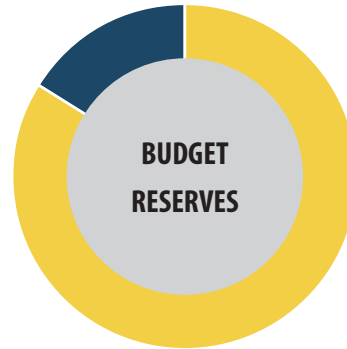
**1.** When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

- F) Other



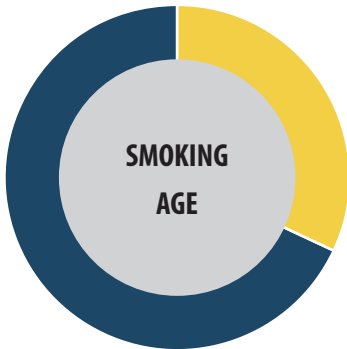

**B) 84%**

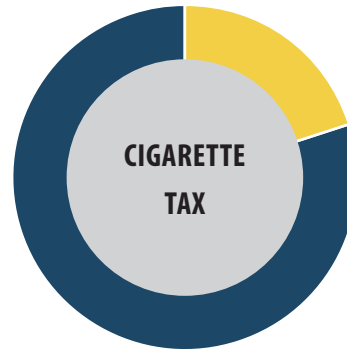
**3.** The minimum legal age to buy cigarettes in Indiana is currently 18. Do you support or oppose raising the smoking age to 21?

**Oppose 32%**

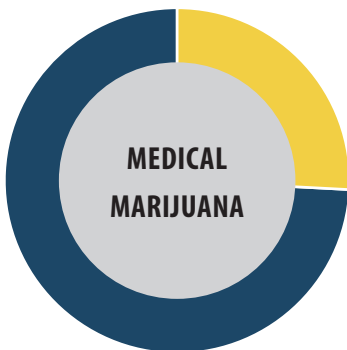
**4.** Do you support or oppose raising Indiana's cigarette tax by \$1.50 per pack in order to deter smoking and pay for health programs?
