
## IREAD-3 Assessment

IREAD-3 is a computerized summative literacy assessment administered to all third graders enrolled in accredited Indiana schools. IREAD-3 measures foundational reading skills that students should have learned through grade 3. Schools are required to provide students who do not pass IREAD-3 with additional 3<sup>rd</sup> grade reading instruction and an opportunity to retake IREAD-3 in the summer following the school year.

## Kindergarten Round-Up!

Our annual Kindergarten Round-Up is scheduled for Wednesday, **April 29<sup>th</sup>**. Children must be 5 years old by August 1, 2020 to be eligible to attend. **Parents need to call the school office at 458-5521 to schedule a time to come in with your child to register.** The hours of Round-Up registration will be 8:30 - 3:15 on the 29<sup>th</sup>.

Scheduled registration times help insure that no one will have to wait for a long time. Parents need to bring their child, a **certified** birth certificate (not a hospital record), a record of immunizations, proof of residency, emergency contact numbers, medical information, and if applicable, legal papers pertaining to custody.
