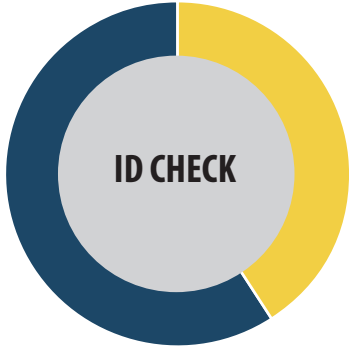

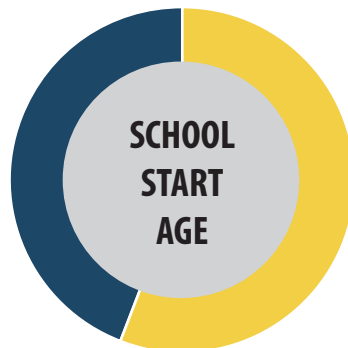

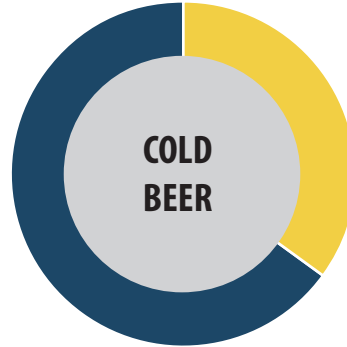
7. Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?

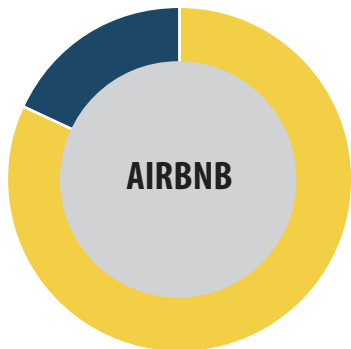
8. Do you support or oppose allowing licensed retail stores, including gas stations, to sell cold beer for carryout? (This is currently limited to liquor stores.)

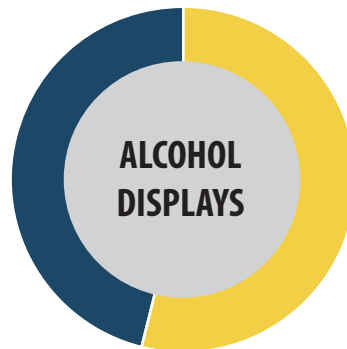
9. Should local governments be able to restrict homeowners from renting out their property with short-term rental services like Airbnb?

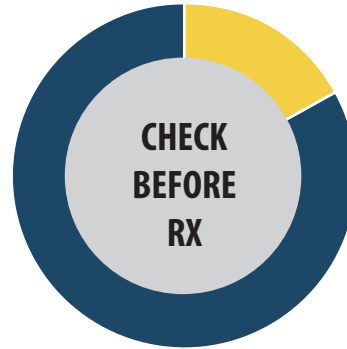
13. Indiana currently charges a fee to get a handgun permit. Do you support or oppose making the permit free?

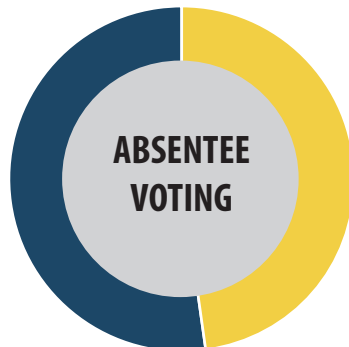
14. In order to limit prescription drug abuse, should doctors be required to check a patient's prescription history before issuing a new prescription?

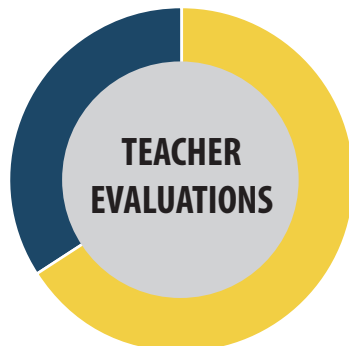
16. Should illegal immigrants who were brought to the United States as children be eligible to receive the same in-state college tuition rate as legal Indiana residents?
