Indiana State. Sen. Jon Ford has represented Hoosiers in western Indiana at the Statehouse since he was elected in 2014. As a state senator, Ford represents Senate District 38, which includes all of Vigo County and the northern part of Clay County.

Ford serves as a member of the Senate Committees on Appropriations; Elections; Family and Child Services; Judiciary; and Public Policy. Ford has also served as chairman of the Indiana Arts Commission.

Professionally, he is the vice president of business development at a nationwide independent food service management company. He served as co-owner and president of All State Manufacturing for 17 years, and is a former board member of the Indiana Manufacturers Association. He holds a bachelor's degree from Misericordia University in business administration and marketing.

Ford's civic involvement goes beyond his service in the General Assembly. He is a former member of several organizations, including the Wabash Valley Community Foundation, Vigo County Youth Soccer, Leadership Wabash Valley, March of Dimes of Wabash Valley and the Swope Art Museum.
