To whom it may concern:

The Saline County Sheriff's Office completed a two-year construction project in 2023 involving the building of a new sheriff's office and jail for Saline County. The project was an \$89 million dollar venture which involved the construction of a 150,000-square-foot facility.

Pauly Jail Building Company was brought into the project to construct and install Detention Hardware which included:

- Detention Doors/Frames to include the locks and hardware
- Security Access Doors/frames
- Stainless Steel Wire Rope Railing System
- Security Glazing
- Detention Gun Lockers
- Industrial Netting
