Health and Wellness Event- January 19th, 2017

This years theme centered around "The Future of Your Yield"--- Brother Fazli Bozal gave a presentation on CRISPR and the ways researchers are using or are working to the use the technology, specifically in the field of medicine, alongside the ethical dilemmas and the challenges they face.

Mixology 101- February 9th, 2017
