



THETA CHI INSPIRE

168th Anniversary Convention New Orleans





The 168th Anniversary Convention and 41st School of Fraternity Practices hosted at the New Orleans Marriott Canal Street was attended by more than 550 collegiate and alumnus brothers. Brothers were guided through the event by emcee Chief Operating Officer Ray Vanlanot and New Orleans native, International Marshal Steve Gonzalez.

Beginning with a powerful drumline performance by the Black Magic Drumline, the event continued over the next four days with 50 breakout and general sessions and two inspirational keynote speakers: Coach Alan K. Saunders (Gamma Xi/San Jose State 1969) and Dr. Richard W. "Doc" Leland (Eta Pi/East Stroudsburg 1997).

Delegates reelected brothers Jim McMahon, Toby Roth, and Tom Thompson to a second term on the Grand Chapter and Kelly Linster to his first. Toby Roth was elected International President and Alan Copeland was elected International Vice President.

Awards were presented throughout the event and all saluted our retiring International President, Creig Andreasen. Appreciation and

gratitude were also extended to Hon. Dennis A. Cardoza (Alpha Psi/Maryland 1981), M. Walt Davis (Delta Upsilon/Arizona State 1965), Richard D. Elder (Gamma Theta/San Diego State 1971), and David A. May (Zeta Sigma/Wisconsin-River Falls 1970) as well as President Joe Clack (Eta Sigma/Arkansas Tech 1980) for completing their terms of service on the Foundation Chapter and the Norwich Housing Corporation, respectively.

In addition, 42 collegiate brothers came to New Orleans one day early to participate in the Resolute Man Event Track—an intensive workshop focusing on leadership development, professional development, and extending the Assisting Hand. These brothers explored professional habits and personal leadership styles, worked with mentors, and problem-solved under pressure. The hard work and dedication of these 42 brothers were celebrated publicly during the Resolute Man Ceremony led by the Grand Chapter.

Participants also had the opportunity to participate in a service event with Theta Chi's national partner, the USO. During Operation Back 2 School, attendees assembled and packed backpacks full











of school supplies to support the families and children of a local U.S. Army unit based in New Orleans. This project would not have been a success without the support of nearly 150 brothers and friends of the Fraternity who generously gave more than \$15,000.

With New Orleans being the home of the National World War II Museum, the Fraternity knew it wanted to recognize the brothers who participated in WWII and plan a visit. First, staff Archivist Emily McMath conducted research, pulled several items from the Fraternity archives, and developed a robust exhibit honoring these brothers. Next, an alumni luncheon was held at BB's Stage Door Canteen inside the museum, complete with a performance by the Victory Belles, a vocal trio who brought the 1940s to life with classic songs that defined the WWII generation. Many brothers were inspired as the singers wandered down into the audience. A keynote address was delivered by Johnathan E. Shertzer (Gamma Kappa/Miami (OH) 1998), executive director of the Medal of Honor Foundation who compared the values of Medal of Honor recipients with the ideals of Theta Chi. Following the luncheon and

the arrival of the collegiate brothers from their USO service project, all enjoyed an afternoon exploring the museum.

Brothers also ventured out into New Orleans and explored (nearly) everything the city had to offer, including music, entertainment, and cuisine. In addition, the Foundation Chapter hosted another successful auction and, in total, raised more than \$62,000 for leadership education and scholarships. To conclude the event, brothers visited Mardi Gras World and gathered at the Grand Oaks Mansion to celebrate 168 years of Theta Chi.

We thank our alumni volunteers who served as faculty and gave their time and talents to lead breakout sessions. We are grateful to the men and women of the International Headquarters staff for their efforts in developing an inspiring and educational experience. We appreciate brothers, young and old, for taking the time to get inspired. We hope to see you at the 172nd Anniversary Convention in San Antonio on July 28–31, 2026!





2023/2024 Reginald E.F. Colley Award

Michael T. Biertzer

(Gamma Phi/Nebraska Wesleyan 2024)

Brother Biertzer served Gamma Phi as IFC Representative, Community Service and Philanthropy Chairman, and President, where he revitalized all remaining activities and operations that had slowed or stopped during the pandemic. He also worked with the Scholarship Chairman to establish plans to help academically suspended brothers return to good standing.

He served on the Fraternity's Chapter Presidents Advisory Council, participated in the recolonization of Alpha Upsilon/Nebraska, and earned the Resolute Man distinction. On campus, he was IFC President and Greek Week Director. He was named the 2022 Greek Emerging Leader, the 2023 Outstanding Greek Achiever, and 2024's Greek Man of the Year.

Biertzer participated in Global Service Learning, student government, student orientation, and other clubs and organizations on campus. He was also a member of the men's varsity swim team where he was a three-time letter winner and nominated in 2024 for Academic All-Conference honors. He assisted Meals on Wheels, volunteered as a tutor, and volunteered at a local hospital and a local hospice organization where he spent nearly 20 hours each month providing support and companionship to individuals nearing the end of their lives.

Biertzer also spent two summers completing a biomedical research experience at the University of South Dakota where he studied Batten disease, a rare neurodegenerative disorder.

Biertzer was inducted into Blue Key Honor Society (where he also served as president), Tri-Beta Biology Honor Society, Order of Omega, and Phi Kappa Phi. He graduated in 2024 with a 4.0 grade point average and two bachelor's degrees in biochemistry and molecular biology. He plans to attend medical school.

Biertzer is Gamma Phi's fifth Colley Award recipient. With Gamma Phi's Kyle R. Goodban (2023) tapped in 2022/2023, this is only the third occasion when brothers from the same chapter received the Colley Award in consecutive years.

#149 Herb W. Morgan, III



James Ralph "Shug" Jordan Award

The "Shug" Jordan Award was created by the Grand Chapter in 1996 in honor and memory of Coach "Shug" Jordan (Chi/Auburn 1932), who served as Auburn's head football coach from 1951 to 1975. Brother Jordan's team went undefeated in the 1957 season and won that year's National Championship. The award is presented to the scholar-athlete who best exemplifies the qualities of leadership, citizenship, academics, brotherhood, loyalty to alma mater, and a commitment to excellence in intercollegiate athletics. In 2023/2024, the Fraternity updated the award to allow for the inclusion and recognition of alumni who met the criteria for the award prior to its creation.


Brigham Freeman (Delta Omega/Ripon 2024)

Double Major - Double Athlete

Brother Freeman graduated with a double major in mathematics and interdisciplinary physics & computer science at Ripon, where he earned a 3.27 GPA and was a member of Order of Omega. He served Ripon's Greek Council as treasurer and vice president, coached off-season workouts, and communicated with recruits and incoming freshmen as the swim and dive team captain. He was also a founding member for Ripon's chapter of Alpha Phi Omega service fraternity. Within Delta Omega Chapter, he served as First Guard, Chaplain, Scholarship Chairman, and Vice President.

On the Ripon swim team, Freeman set all-time marks in the 500-yard, 1,000-yard, and 1,650-yard freestyles; the 100-yard and 200-yard butterfly; and 400-yard IM. He was a top five finisher within the Division III Midwest Conference 12 separate times (including a medalist honor in the 200-medley relay) and named as the team's MVP in 2023. Freeman also played on Ripon's tennis team and received the men's tennis Best Teammate Award for his performance and leadership.

Alan K. Saunders (Gamma Xi/San Jose State 1969)

Inaugural Recipient

Coach Saunders was a star swimmer in high school and was inducted into the San Francisco Prep Hall of Fame. He is also a member of the San Jose State University Hall of Fame. He earned Academic All-American football honors as a threeyear starter and team captain at defensive back and wide receiver from 1966-1968. After graduation, he earned a master's degree in education from Stanford in 1970.

He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at USC under John McKay. Within the NFL, he was part of 15 playoff teams, five division titles, and one Super Bowl championship. His offense ranked first in total offense 20 times over his career.

Coach Saunders is an accomplished distance runner who has served on the "Shug" Jordan Award selection committee for nearly a decade, contributing greatly to debates and discussions.





My Baseball Story:

Nick Del Calzo (Gamma Mu/Bowling Green 1960) has created a memorable book, My Baseball Story: The Game's Influence on America. Brother Del Calzo is contributing his royalties from the book to the Foundation Chapter of Theta Chi to establish a leadership scholarship for

brothers who attend officer training conferences and/or our School of Fraternity Practices.

including Carlton Bennett (Zeta Pi/Old Dominion 1972), Pete Mackey (Alpha Phi/Alabama 1978), Jim McMahon (Zeta Epsilon/Long Beach State 1979), and Pat O'Connor (Chi/Auburn 1978).

Ben Hill (Eta Kappa/James Madison 2002) and Nick Hoke (Alpha Iota/Indiana 2014) served on the team that reviewed submissions. The book is dedicated to the late Larry Coffman (Gamma Mu/Bowling Green 1960) who worked with Nick as an editor on several of his previous projects. Larry is an author of one of the stories included in the book.

Ski-U-Mah: Hail Minnesota! 100 Years of Alpha Pi Chapter

Theta Chi has a long and storied history at the University of Minnesota. Its predecessor organization, the Thulanian Club, was formed in 1889. It produced two Minnesota governors: **J.A. Preus** (1902) and **Theodore Christianson** (1906), who also served as International Vice President on the Grand Chapter. By 1910, they owned a house with room for 25 men and several years later during WWI, 94 members answered the call to serve their country.

100 years is a long time. And in that time more than 1,400 men added their names to our roster. Each man came because he wanted to be part of something bigger than himself on a very big campus. They each left as better brothers, better husbands, better fathers, better men.

Not so long ago, Alpha Pi Chapter closed its doors. **Paul "Yogi" Norstrem** (1986) was serving on the Grand Chapter at the time, and he had the reluctant duty to vote to close his own chapter.

After regaling him with tales of the Thulanian Club, members of the Grand Chapter convince Goldy Gopher to accept the Badge of Theta Chi.

Innesota. Then, a group of Resolute that Theta Chi was not dead at Fraternity. I remember telling Doug

For 13 long years, it was winter for Theta Chi at Minnesota. Then, a group of Resolute Men—men of substance and character—determined that Theta Chi was not dead at Minnesota. We enlisted the help of our International Fraternity. I remember telling **Doug Allen** (Delta Beta/Georgia 1990), who was International President at the time, that my son, **Mitch Andreasen** (2018), had been given Goldy Gopher gear from the time he was 5 years old and if he went to Minnesota, there was no Theta Chi for him to join.

Though a young staffer named **Mike Mayer** (Epsilon Phi/Central Missouri 2004) had some initial success in 2005, it wasn't until 2012 when **Cory Loveless** (Phi/North Dakota State 2012) and **Joe Macko** (Zeta Tau/Michigan-Flint 2012) arrived on campus and established a solid foundation that we began to make significant progress toward Alpha Pi's return.

Cory and Joe don't understand how important their service was to us old guys from the '80s. To these men, and the men who came after them—the guys who reestablished our letters on this campus—for them, I am eternally grateful.

For one year Alpha Pi was a colony. Then a chapter with a meeting room in a residence hall. Then renters in a house. And now, we own that house. And we begin our second century at the U.

I am proud to be a Theta Chi and I am proud to celebrate our history at Minnesota.

Next, during our banquet, Adrian College President Dr. Jeffrey Docking spoke about Theta Chi's long history and positive impact at the college and beyond, and his belief that a strong Greek community is vital to the College's long-term success. Several alumni were recognized for awards they had received over the summer, most notably **Jim Grissinger** (1990) for the Earl D. Rhodes Theta Chi for Life Award and **Vince Crawford** (1988) and **Jim Carlson** (1989) for their joint Sydney Ann Gilpin Lewis Award for their "Kickin' the Asphalt Out of Cancer" bicycle team's noble efforts that raised \$100,000+.

One of the most poignant moments was **Rev. Dr. Terry Robinson's** (1966) presentation of framed tracings of **Michael Kelly Thompson's** (1965) name from the wall of the Vietnam Memorial to each recipient of the Michael Kelly Thompson Scholarship, which had been established in his memory shortly after the Vietnam War by Dr. Robinson. Our evening ended on a high note as brothers—one by one and completely unplanned—began pledging charitable gifts to the chapter, raising over \$35,000 for housing upgrades to sustain our next 60 years.

The Zeta Beta Chapter is full of rich history, tradition, and pride. The health of the chapter remains strong, and our brothers are more energized than ever. Cheers to the next 60 years!


ALLEN L. McCOY (GAMMA TAU/DRAKE 1954)

April 26, 1933-September 21, 2024

Known as the "Voice of the Phoenix Suns," Al McCoy served as the play-by-play announcer for the NBA team for more than 50 years and served as the team's Senior Vice President of Broadcasting. McCoy was called the dean of NBA play-by-play announcers and was known for famous catchphrases such as "Shazam," "Zing Go the Strings," and "Heartbreak Hotel."

McCoy attended Drake University where he pledged Gamma Tau Chapter. He graduated with a degree in drama-speech and then began his broadcasting career at KJFJ Radio in Webster City, IA, in 1951.

McCoy was the longest-tenured team broadcaster in NBA history, calling Suns games for 51 years, from September 27, 1972, through May 11, 2023. He was as synonymous with the Suns as Charles Barkley, Steve Nash, and Devin Booker



and was on the sidelines during the team's NBA Finals appearances in 1976, 1993, and 2021.

Besides working for the Phoenix Suns, McCoy also did play-by-play for the now-defunct Phoenix Giants and Phoenix Roadrunners along with Arizona State (football and basketball) and the Arizona Diamondbacks.

In 2007, he received the 18th Annual Curt Gowdy Media Award from the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. He was honored with a Lifetime Achievement Award from the House of Broadcasting and was inducted as the 15th member of the Phoenix Suns Ring of Honor in March 2021. He received an Alumni Achievement Award from Drake in 1994. Theta Chi Fraternity presented the Distinguished Achievement Award to McCoy in 2016.

NBA Commissioner Adam Silver said, "Al McCoy was a master of his craft. He entertained generations of fans with his distinct delivery and unbridled love for the game and was a beloved friend to so many of us in the NBA community."

As brothers gathered in New Orleans for the 168th Anniversary Convention, many were anxiously awaiting the biennial Foundation Chapter Auction and placing bids on different items and experiences. Sadly, as the Convention began, we received word that our auctioneer, Fred Wiese, had suddenly joined the Chapter Eternal.

To further capitalize on Zeta Sigma's annual Cornerstone Banquet to acquire gifts for the chapter's scholarship fund, Dave May (1970) introduced an auction and procured the services of Brother Wiese, who was a trained auctioneer. Dave secured items and experiences of interest from alumni and friends and Fred called for bids, encouraged some friendly competition, and slammed the gavel. Due to their success over the years, Dave, while serving on the board of directors, encouraged the Foundation Chapter to establish an alumni auction during each International Convention, with proceeds going toward academic scholarships and leadership education.

The plans came to fruition in 2018, and once again, Fred dutifully answered the call. He served as the auctioneer at the 162nd Anniversary Convention in Las Vegas, the 165th Anniversary Celebration in Lexington, KY, and the 166th Anniversary Convention in Washington, D.C. He was set to serve as auctioneer during the Convention in New Orleans until he passed away peacefully after a three-year battle with cancer.

Fred loved his family and enjoyed traveling, trail rides, visiting antique shops, and swing and ballroom dancing. He was knowledgeable in military history and collected military figurines. Fred was fun-loving and a great neighbor, always ready to help someone in need and never stopped working until his death.

Fred was loved and held in high regard by his brothers both at the local and International levels. The 168th Anniversary Convention honored Brother Wiese and his memory with a formal resolution noting his service to the Fraternity.

Cleveland Icon & Entrepreneur

NICHOLAS J. MILETI (GAMMA MU/BOWLING GREEN 1953)

April 22, 1931-August 21, 2024

Nick Mileti believed in the city of Cleveland and used all his talents, networks, and business acumen to leave a legacy.

Mileti joined Theta Chi and worked his way through college as a busboy in a sorority house and as a promotion man for a band. He then worked through law school at Ohio State, often holding several jobs at the same time.

After a stint in the Army, Nick became the prosecuting attorney for Lakewood, OH, and assisted with the development of an apartment building for senior citizens. After its success, Mileti emerged as the country's leading authority in the development and operation of independent living facilities and multi-purpose senior centers.

In 1968, he purchased the Cleveland Arena and the Cleveland Barons hockey team. Next, when the NBA began seeking expansion teams in 1970, Mileti led the group that established the Cleveland Cavaliers. Two years later, his group also bought MLB's Cleveland Indians, helping to prevent the team from moving to New Orleans. His time as owner was short-lived, however. By 1980, he had moved on to sports journalism and writing, but Cleveland never forgot the leadership of its native son. In recognition of his efforts, Mileti was inducted into the Cavaliers Wall of Honor in 2019.

Mileti remained loyal to not only Cleveland but to his Fraternity and his alma mater. Nick donated all the funds for the complete decoration and furnishing of Gamma Mu's new on-campus house in 1961. He co-founded the first BGSU Alumni Chapter, is rumored to have hired more

BGSU graduates than just about anyone and was named one of the prominent 100 graduates of BGSU. He also served on the BGSU board of trustees, as chairman of the BGSU alumni association, and made many other contributions. He received BGSU's Distinguished Alumnus Award, the Community Service Award, an honorary doctorate, and the alumni center on campus was named in his honor.

HON. R. A. "JIM" RANDALL, JR. (THETA CHI/GRAND CHAPTER HONORARY 2005)

August 31, 1940-August 9, 2024



In 2004, while doing research for the 150th Anniversary Convention, Doug Allen (Delta Beta/Georgia 1990) explored the life of Theta Chi hero Phil S. Randall (Alpha/Norwich 1886), who, as an incoming freshman in 1881, convinced James Michael Holland (Alpha/Norwich 1883) to initiate him along with his friend Henry B. Hersey (Alpha/Norwich 1885), thus saving the Fraternity. Later, Randall's father, Civil War hero Col. Francis V. Randall, became a vice president at Norwich University and was made an Honorary Member of Theta Chi.

Doug read that Brother Randall moved to Minnesota and served as a judge and had remained involved in Theta Chi until his death in 1960. Living in Minnesota, Doug was curious if there were any members of the Randall family still in the area. He soon located Phil's grandson, Judge R.A. "Jim" Randall, and arranged a meeting.

Judge Randall indicated his grandfather had lived out his later years in his childhood home and the two had even shared a bedroom. "Theta Chi was very important

to my grandfather, and my grandfather was very important to me," said Judge Randall. He also shared pictures and mementos of his grandfather.

Following his graduation from Gonzaga University, Jim served in the U.S. Marine Corps and then earned his law degree from the University of Minnesota. He practiced criminal defense law in private practice and as a public defender for 17 years. Randall's passion was protecting the underserved across the state of Minnesota, and he connected with Native Americans across the Iron Range and defended them against the power of the state. Following his appointment to the Minnesota Court of Appeals in 1984, he served full time until 2008, and nine additional years as a retired judge.

As Judge Randall had not had an opportunity to join a fraternity, an invitation from Theta Chi was extended and on March 19, 2005, Judge Randall and his son, Jim, were initiated into Theta Chi Chapter and assigned roster numbers 2 and 3, respectively.

Judge Randall served as a keynote speaker at 2005's Chapter Leadership Conference held at the University of Dayton and again at the 150th Anniversary Convention held at Norwich University in 2006. During the 158th Anniversary Convention in Minneapolis, Judge Randall and his son Jim formally presented the Phil S. Randall Success in Recruitment Award to all chapters that had initiated 25 or more men during the 2013/2014 academic year.

The Theta Chi Chapter of Theta Chi Fraternity designation was set aside through legislation approved at the 132nd Anniversary Convention in 1988 and honors individuals who have been selected by the Grand Chapter for membership. Brother Randall is the first member of the Theta Chi Chapter to join the Chapter Eternal.


