## LEGISLATION MATTERS

### Program Overview

Members can hear directly from elected officials on current policy issues and are welcome to advocate for the business community's position. Attendees can vote on questions that allow elected officials to gauge the local business community's feelings on the topic.

### History

Legislation Matters is a 23-year old tradition that has enabled members to meet with and express their thoughts and concerns to elected officials from every level of government.

### Event Engagement

During the Statehouse luncheons, 70-100 Aspire members and state legislators gather together. Over 250 business and community leaders attend the Greenwood Mayor's State of the City. We anticipate 75 attendees each for Municipal Matters and Pints + Policy.

### History

Over 10 years ago, Aspire began its focus on women in business. The program's events varied over the years from the "miniature golf classic" to our professional development day, "Symposium." To support the women of our business community, Aspire's Women Leaders currently consists of a half-day workshop offering professional development programs and networking opportunities. 2023 was the inaugural year for W.I.L.D. and we are excited to see the connectivity and synergy of this group.

### Event Engagement

Approximately 125 Central Indiana (mostly Johnson and Marion County) business women and community leaders attend the half-day workshop. Attendees are at all career and business ownership stages. W.I.L.D. peer networking events average between 30-40 attendees.

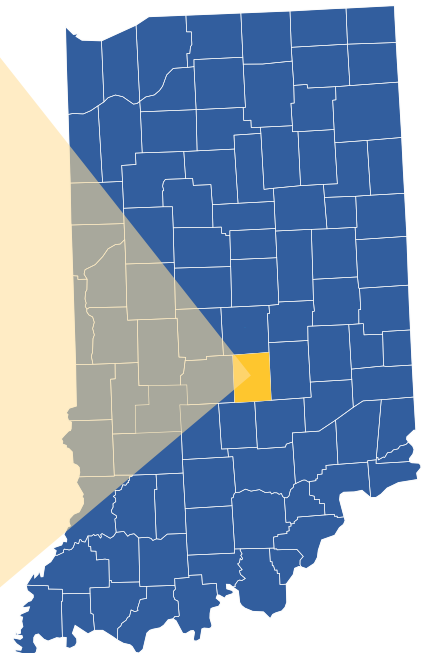
