DIY Ancient Greek Pottery

Supplies: Terra Cotta Pot, Black Sharpie, Black Paint, or Black Paint Marker, Painter's Tape

Directions:

1. Choose a pattern for the bottom of your pot. Practice drawing it on a piece of paper.
2. Draw/paint the pattern along the bottom edge of your pot.
3. Choose a pattern for the top of your pot. Practice drawing it on a piece of paper.
4. Draw/paint the pattern along the top edge of your pot.
5. Choose your design for the center of your pottery. This can be one of the Greek gods symbols, another pattern, something written in the Greek alphabet, be creative!
6. Draw/paint your design on the center of your pot. Let dry.
7. Please share a picture of your completed pottery on our social media page!

Sharpie Tie Dye Shirt

Supplies: White T-shirt, Sharpies, Alcohol, Rubber Bands, Small Plastic Cups, Dropper

Directions:

1. Place a plastic cup inside your shirt so that the fabric is stretched over the top of the cup. Secure with rubber bands.
2. Use sharpies to make a design with white space remaining. (Dots and Dashes are great.)
3. Use a dropper to drip rubbing alcohol on your design.
4. After a few seconds of the alcohol hitting the design is when the fun begins. The more alcohol you add the more the colors will run.
5. Continue the process until you are happy with your t-shirt.
6. Set your marker by ironing it on the "high" setting with no steam. Then wash and dry on high heat.

* Please do this activity in a well ventilated area.
