Your IAFP Delegation attended the AAFP Congress of Delegates held in Washington D.C. in September 2022. Due to an illness, Alternate Delegate Dr. Bernard Richard was replaced with Dr. Nykki Boersma, who served alongside Alternate Delegate David Schultz. Drs. Marker and Patel served

as your voting Delegates.

This was the first COD held in person since 2019 and it was so great to see our colleagues from around the country in person. The COD kicked off with a Town Hall meeting where we heard from the three AAFP Presidents and the CEO. Congress sessions kicked off on Monday morning with the usual greetings, but we quickly kicked the meeting into high gear by attending to the work of the Congresses held in 2020 and 2021. The activities of those two virtual Congresses required ratification by this year's live Congress – and the vote of ratification passed.

We then proceeded on to the work of the 2022 Congress with lively debate about a whole host of topics that spanned the spectrum from medical to social and legal to political. Reference committee debate was vigorous but cordial, even on several contentious topics around reproductive rights. In the end, the congress voted to continue to support a broad definition of reproductive rights while bolstering support to avoid physician and patient criminalization in future legislative efforts and supporting a physician's rights of conscience.

 The resolution from the IAFP Congress of Delegates regarding tax law and small, independent practices had excellent Reference Committee debate with unanimous support and was referred to the AAFP Board of Directors for further action. We supported this referral as the issue is complex and may have a significant fiscal note to move forward.

Our Indiana candidate for AAFP Board of Directors, Teresa Lovins, was successful in her bid for a full 3-year seat. Naturally, the large delegation from Indiana that traveled to D.C. to support her at the Meet The Candidates night and Hospitality Night would like to take all the credit. However, it was probably the fact that she's an amazing candidate who knows her stuff and was able to express that well that affected her victory! Regardless of the reason...she won and your Indiana support team couldn't have been happier to support her. Indiana is 3rd in the nation for number of person-years that we have had a representative on the AAFP Board of Directors. Congratulations, Teresa!!
