



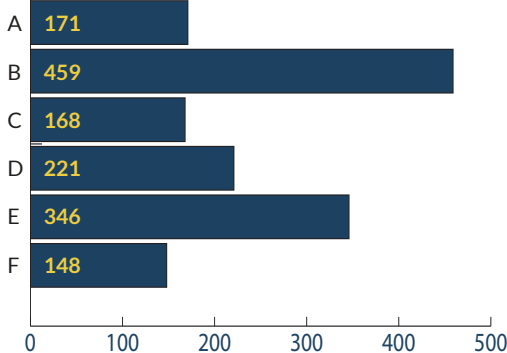

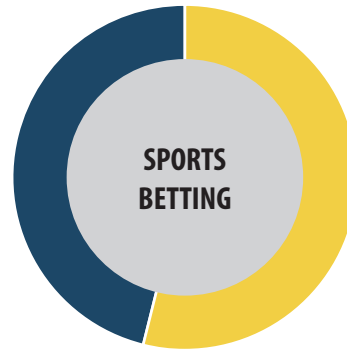
- 1.** When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

- F) Other



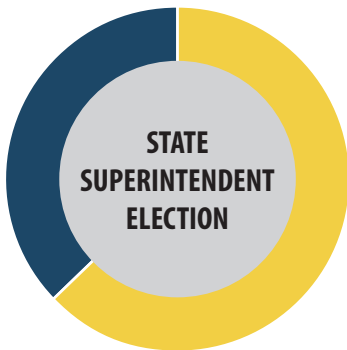
- 2.** Do you support or oppose legalizing sports betting in Indiana?

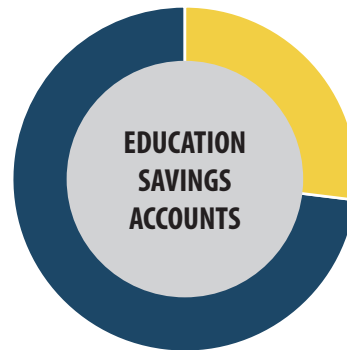

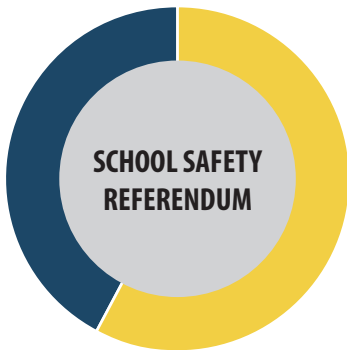
- 4.** Do you support or oppose giving parents of special-needs children the option to use state educational funding for services such as private-school tuition and developmental therapy?

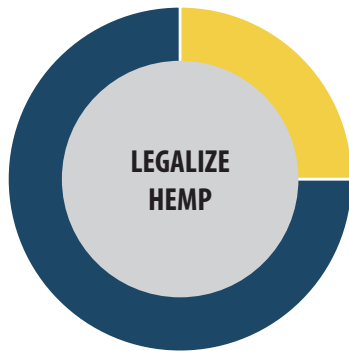

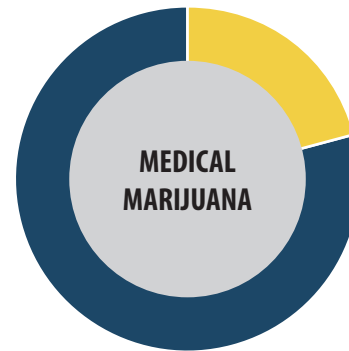

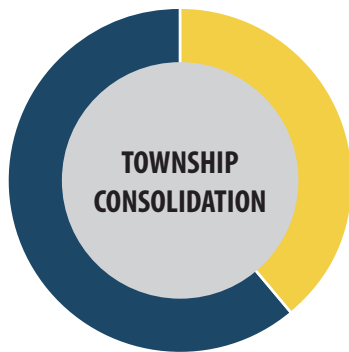
- 7.** Should Indiana legalize marijuana for medical use?
