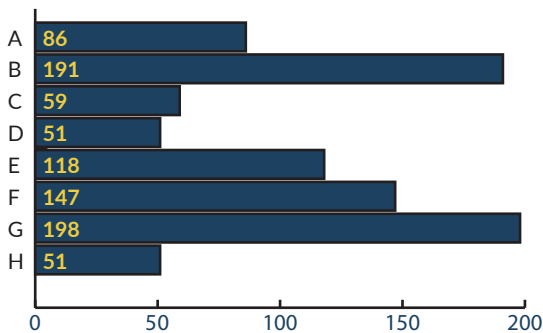
## STATE SENATOR AARON FREEMAN

### BUDGET PRIORITIES

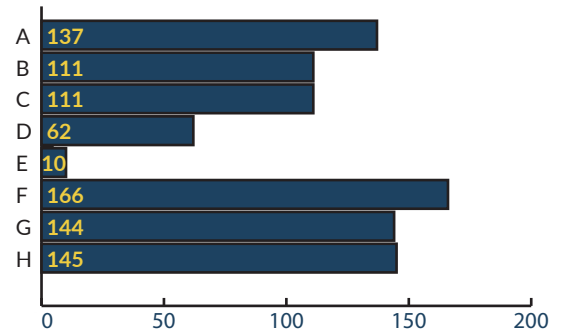
- A) Funding for mental health and addiction treatment

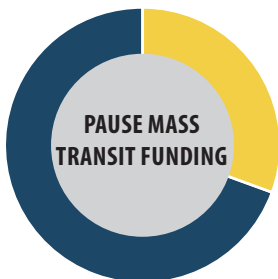
2. Which one of the following is the most important for me to focus on as your state senator?
