Why should I apply?

Borst Fellows gain valuable hands-on experience within state government by assisting the Senate Majority Fiscal Analysts and Senate Leadership with policy research and fiscal analysis throughout the legislative process.

What are the responsibilities?

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, tracking legislation with a fiscal impact, staffing fiscal committees, researching various policy topics, and observing all aspects of the legislative session.

LAWRENCE M. BORST FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested students must submit applications to the IU O'Neill School of Public and Environmental Affairs by March 19.

Qualified applicants are O'Neill School of Public and Environmental Affairs MPA students with a minimum 3.0 grade point average and an interest in learning the state finance and budget process.

Preferred applicants will have successfully completed or should plan to try to take the public budgeting and finance, economics, and statistics courses *prior to the spring semester of their fellowship or during the course of their fellowship.*
