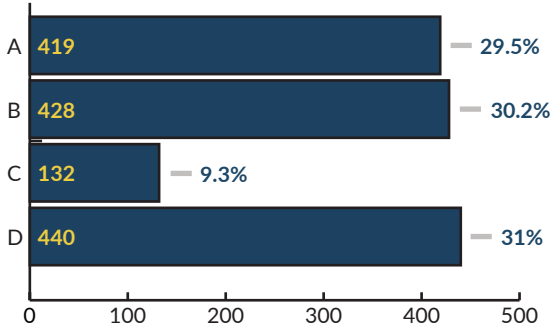

BUDGET SURPLUS

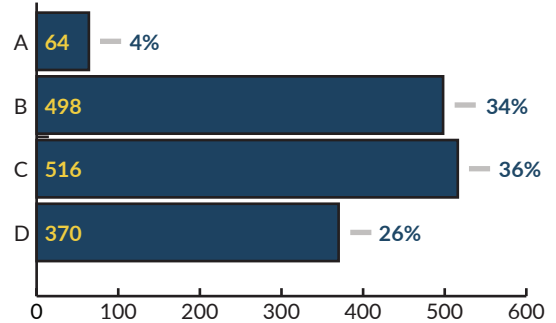
- A) Return money directly to taxpayers through a one-time payment

ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH CARE

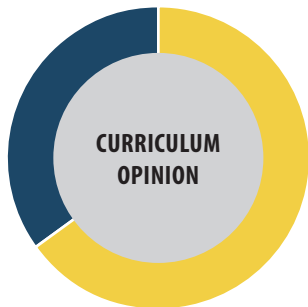

4. Indiana law currently allows counties to opt in to post-election audits that check the accuracy of voting results. Should Indiana *require* counties to participate in these post-election audits?

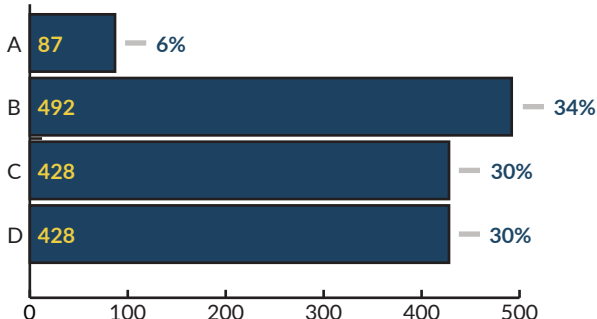
