



For those attending the SEUSSICAL Jr. Audition Prep Session, here are the answers to some commonly asked questions:

- **Who should attend?**
 - Actor auditioning and one parent.
 - We recommend only one parent attend per family as seating is limited.
- **Why should a parent attend?**
 - Much of the information imparted regards logistics. (i.e. audition procedure, timing, what to prepare, etc.) We find that this information is helpful for parents helping their child prepare.
- **What should I expect to learn?**
 - As mentioned above, we will be going over all the procedural components of the audition, good audition technique and information about roles available and casting policies. This will ensure that you know what to prepare, how to present it and how auditions work, in general, at Civic Theatre. There will also be discussion of the rehearsal and performance schedule, associated fees and parent volunteer opportunities.
- **Will there be a dance component to the Prep Session?**
 - No. However, the choreographer will be on hand to speak to her plans for the audition and answer any questions.
- **Do I need to have Jr. Civic classroom experience to audition?**
 - No. The auditions are open to any child age 8-14.
- **How long will the Prep Session last?**
 - 45 minutes to 1 hour. **The session will begin promptly at the listed time.**
- **Where will the session be held?**
 - Smith Hall in the Education Suite at Civic Theatre.

- **Do I need to bring anything to the Prep Session?**
 - Only your ears and, if you prefer to do so, something to take notes on. Some handouts will be provided.
- **There are two Prep Sessions (March 21st and April 12th). Do I need to attend both?**
 - No. The sessions are identical in content.
