


2020 SURVEY RESULTS


STATE SENATOR JIM BUCK

- The minimum age to buy tobacco and vaping products in Indiana is 18. This lines up with the minimum age to vote and serve in the military, but it also contributes to Indiana having the 7th highest smoking rate in the nation. Do you support or oppose raising the smoking and vaping age to 21?




- Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?
