## Membership Eligibility Criteria

## **Criteria for 200**

The chapter has vaguely defined MES.

- Academic:
  - o 1. 1st Semester Freshmen must have had a GPA of 3.0/4.0 or higher in high school, show above entering SHSU average scores on the SAT/ACTS, or otherwise demonstrate academic excellence through awards and scholarship.
  - o 2. Upperclassmen must have a Grade Point Average of 2.5 or higher before the chapter will give him a bid.
- Active Involvement:
  - o 1. 1st Semester Freshmen who will need to have been a part of teams, organizations, or clubs in high school, and show that they have a dedication to any other organizations they have been in.
  - o 2. Upperclassmen must have been or are still a part of some sort of student organization in order to be given a bid from the chapter.
- Conduct:
  - o Potential New Members who display or are known to have conduct issues that may pose a threat to MRG's or SHSU Student Handbook will not be given a bid.
- Finances:
  - o Potential New Member must provide verbal acknowledgement of ability to pay full new member dues.
- Demonstration of Delt Values
  - o The potential new member must demonstrate prior use of our Delta Tau Delta value system.

## **Criteria for 400**

The chapter has clearly defined MES.

- Academic:
  - o 1. 1st Semester Freshmen must have had a GPA of 3.0/4.0 or higher in high school, show above entering SHSU average scores on the SAT/ACTS, or otherwise demonstrate academic excellence through awards and scholarship.
  - o 2. Upperclassmen must have a Grade Point Average of 2.5 or higher before the chapter will give him a bid.
- Active Involvement:
  - o 1. 1st Semester Freshmen who will need to have been a part of teams, organizations, or clubs in high school, and show that they have a dedication to any other organizations they have been in.
  - o 2. Upperclassmen must have been or are still a part of some sort of student organization in order to be given a bid from the chapter.
- Conduct:
  - o Potential New Members who display or are known to have conduct issues that may pose a threat to MRG's or SHSU Student Handbook will not be given a bid.
- Finances:
  - o Potential New Member must provide verbal acknowledgement of ability to pay full

- new member dues.
- Demonstration of Delt Values
  - o The potential new member must demonstrate prior use of our Delta Tau Delta value system.
- On pages 5-6 of the packet. The chapter has highlighted and defined our membership requirements. These are located in our yearly growth plan, updated by our recruitment chairman.

### **Criteria for 600**

**In addition to the 400 level requirement**, the chapter demonstrates how the recruitment committee vets candidates by describing (in 200 words or less) how the chapter verifies potential members meet these standards.

- The chapter practices 365 24/7 recruitment. Before candidates are considered for a bid, the recruitment committee maintains a names list indicating where the candidate is in the recruitment process. The names list is found on pages 7-26.
- During the recruitment process, the recruitment committee has potential new members fill out scholarship applications listing activity involvement, academic honors and GPA, and also more in depth thought questions. These scholarships applications, in conjunction with information gained from recruitment conversations are used to collect data to make the membership eligibility decision. Examples of the scholarship are found starting on page 27-.31
- Once the data is collected, the recruitment committee compiles the data in a spreadsheet to conduct their eligibility analysis. The spreadsheet with the membership eligibility analysis is found on pages 5. A power point presentation used at bid session with criteria address is found on pages 32-33.

### **Criteria for 800**

**In addition to the 600 level requirement**, the chapter shows evidence of implementing the MES in the bid voting process.

- The recruitment committee conducts an analysis of potential new members before bid session occurs. If they meet our criteria, the potential new member is presented to the chapter bid session for a general vote. A spreadsheet with the membership eligibility analysis is found on page 5-6. A power point presentation used at bid session with criteria address is found on pages 32-33.

### **Criteria for 1000**

**In addition to the 800 level requirement**, the chapter's MES are high enough to show a clear commitment to becoming the recognized leader of creative leadership and excellence.

- Addressed Chapter Issue: Epsilon Zeta Chapter experienced a decrease in academic GPA performance for 2017 compared to 2016. Within our membership eligibility standards, we enforce a minimum academic GPA standard for both entering high school freshmen and upper classmen to address this chapter issue. Please see our membership eligibility criteria on page 5-6 for evidence of the criteria. - Promoting a Commitment to Excellence: Epsilon Zeta continues to be an influential organization at Sam Houston State University. Our membership eligibility criteria seek to identify men who will be active and engaged on campus. 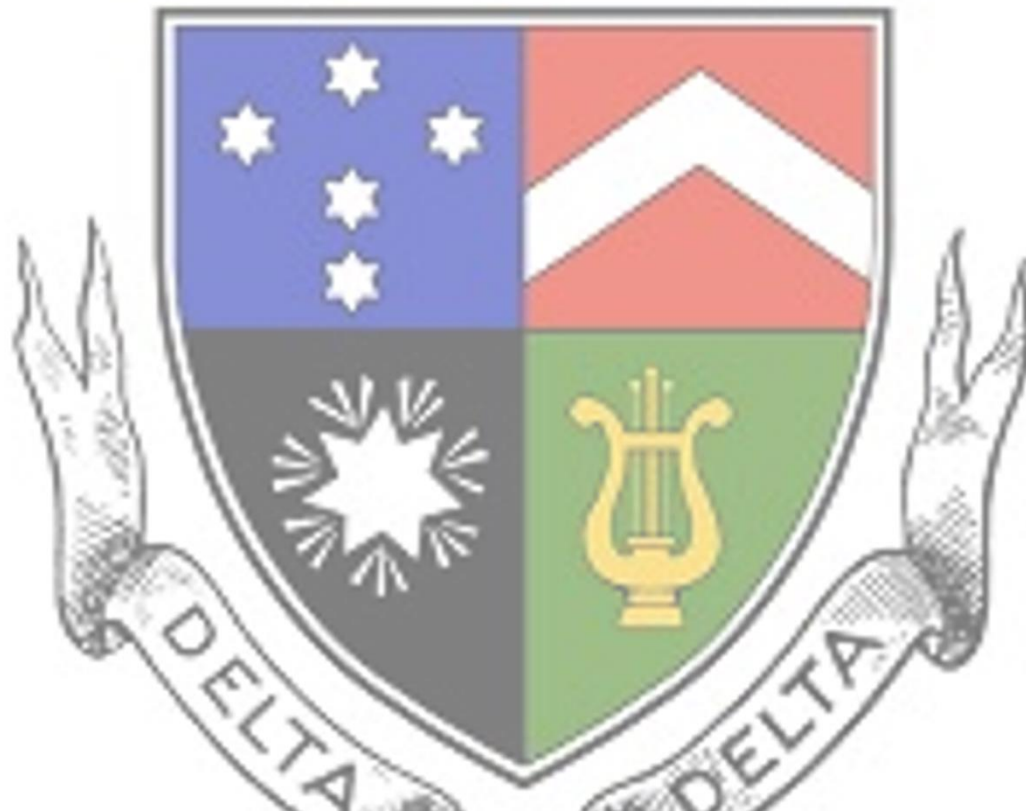

**What are you looking for in your experience at SHSU?**

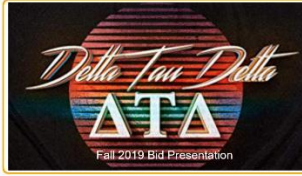
What I am looking for in SHSU is to forge bonds with other students and future graduates at SHSU that will last throughout our lifetimes.
