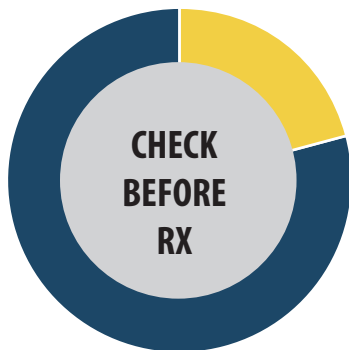
**2.** Do you think criminals should receive longer sentences if they committed their crime because of prejudice against a specific trait of the victim such as race, religion or gender?

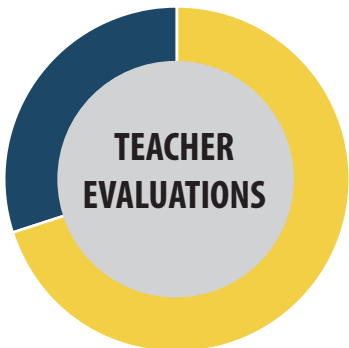
**4.** Hoosiers currently must register about a month before Election Day in order to vote. Should the law be changed so you can both register and vote on Election Day?

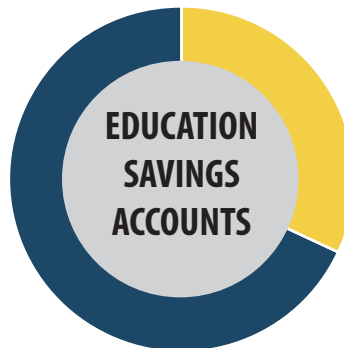
**5.** Should student scores from Indiana's statewide test be used as part of teachers' job performance evaluations?

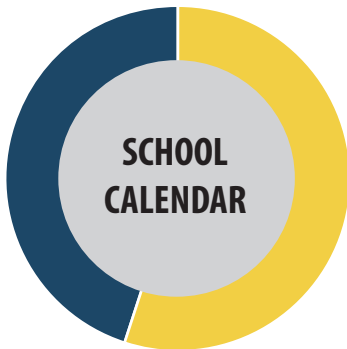
**8.** Should a person be required to pay a fee and undergo a background check in order to get a permit to carry a handgun in public?

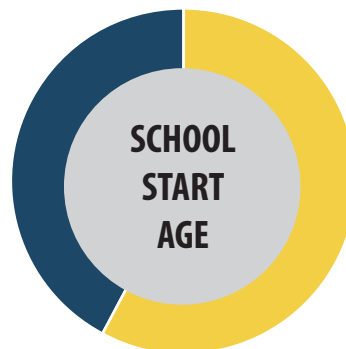
**9.** Indiana schools currently set their own calendars. Should schools be prohibited from starting classes before the last Monday in August?
