
- 1.** Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?


- 4.** Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health-care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?
