
## STATE SENATOR CHIP PERFECT

The following charts represent responses to the multiple-choice questions offered on my mailed and online survey.


1 • Thinking about schools and what is being taught in the classroom, which of the following statements comes closer to your own opinion?

B) I feel schools are forcing a political agenda that doesn't belong in the classroom.




**2.** Do you support or oppose the following statement? Parents should be given more opportunities to choose the best school for their child, whether that be public, private, religious or charter school.


- A) Reducing government spending
