Privacy Policy

This personally identifiable information is used only to collect your contribution and/or event registration and to acknowledge receipt of your donation for tax purposes.

Online Data Security

Alternatives Incorporated helps protect personally identifiable information by using both online and offline security methods, including firewalls, passwords and restricted physical access to the places where your information is stored. To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the correct use of information, we have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. Our staff members sign a Confidentiality Statement and are trained to observe our security procedures. All internal security procedures are regularly reviewed and revised, if necessary.
