




 Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?




2. Do you support or oppose allowing licensed retail stores, including gas stations, to sell cold beer for carryout? (This is currently limited to liquor stores.)




Should local governments be able to restrict homeowners from renting out their property with short-term rental services like Airbnb?




Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health-care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?

6. Current Indiana law requires a child's education to begin by age 7. Do you support or oppose changing the law so that a child's education must begin by age 5?




