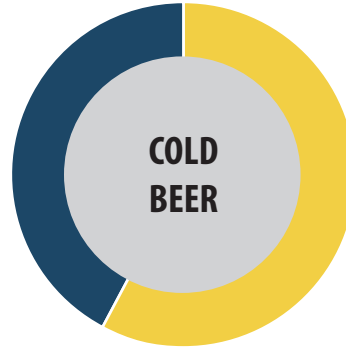
- 1.** Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?

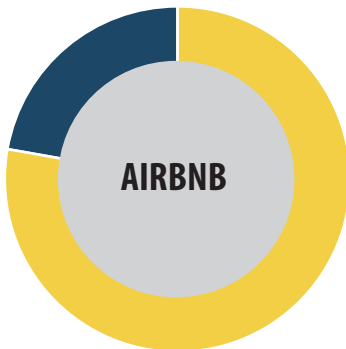
- 2.** Do you support or oppose allowing licensed retail stores, including gas stations, to sell cold beer for carryout? (This is currently limited to liquor stores.)

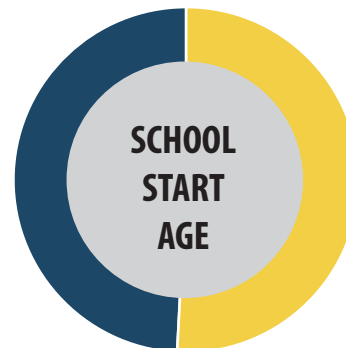
- 5.** Hoosiers currently must register about a month before Election Day in order to vote. Should the law be changed so you can both register and vote on Election Day?
