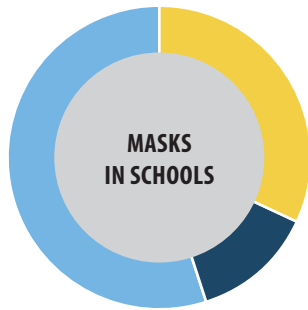

1. In response to COVID-19, which policy do you support regarding masks in schools?

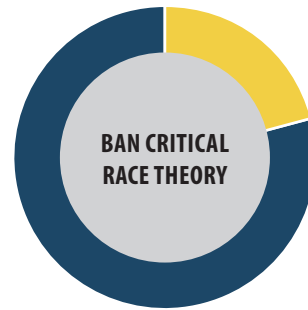
MASKS IN SCHOOLS

- C) Local officials should make decisions about mask policies for their schools.



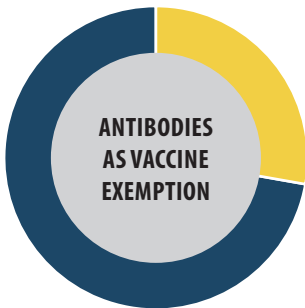

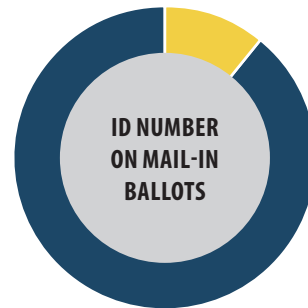
Yes 79%

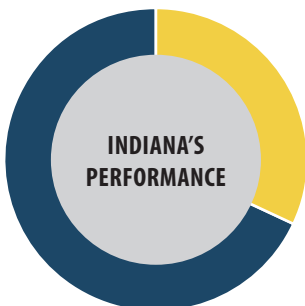
Yes 72%
