

Vocational Rehabilitation Services

Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VRS) is a state agency that works with individuals with disabilities to achieve employment goals. Goals should be based on interests, strengths and priorities. VRS may be able to help with such services as:

- *Job training, including vocational school, university/college, and on-the-job.
- *Job placement assistance and follow-up support including supported employment
- *Vocational counseling and guidance
- *Medical treatment to correct or modify a physical or mental impairment
- *Rehabilitation technology such as assistive devices and services

VRS should be contacted during the final two years of high school

Not everyone is determined eligible

A VRS application must be completed to determine eligibility for services
